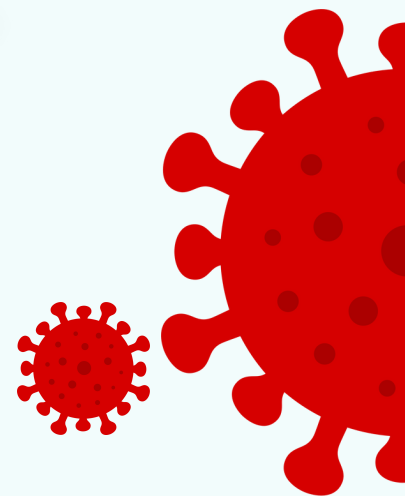


MEASLES IMMUNIZATION RECOMMENDATIONS



Children

- standard two-dose regimen is recommended
- first vaccine given at 12 months, second vaccine given between 4-6 years
- some children may be behind due to the COVID-19 pandemic

Adults born before 1970

- generally assumed to have natural immunity
- one booster dose is recommended prior to travel outside of Canada (unless there is lab evidence of immunity)

Adults born in 1970 or later

- adults born in 1970 or later have likely received one dose of measles containing vaccine (two doses became standard in 1996)
- those who have received only one dose are eligible to receive a second dose if they are a health care worker, post secondary student or planning to travel outside of Canada
