

Stewardship Reflection

That we take time, every day, talking to God - praising Him, thanking Him and asking for His guidance. "Jesus turned and saw them following him and said to them, 'What are you looking for?" - John 1:38 When we recognize who we are, it's easier to find what we are looking for. Once we see ourselves, and others, as children of God, we spend less time looking for the material comforts of the world. Instead, our hearts long for something deeper that can only be filled by God. Ask God daily how He wants you to live the life He intended for you.

## God calls us first. Why is responding correctly the most important decision in your life?

The Gospel reading describes the detailed calling of Jesus' first disciples. As Jesus was walking by, John the Baptist witnessed that Jesus was the Lamb of God. When the two disciples heard John's words, they followed Jesus, yet it was Jesus who turned to them and spoke first. "What are you looking for?" The two disciples responded by remaining with Jesus. Andrew (one of the disciples) went further by telling his brother Simon about Christ. Even though Andrew brought Simon (Peter/Cephas) to Jesus, it was Jesus who again spoke first. Jesus already knew who Simon was, and He already knew who we were. The disciples could have accepted Him or rejected Him. Jesus speaks to us first, and we then have a choice in how we respond, which is the most important decision in our life. Let me use this illustration. A little boy was watching his Dad go over the insurance policies at the table. "What are those?", the boy asked. "That's car insurance, son", the Father answered. "If something happens to the caraccident or it's stolen we can get it repaired or replaced." "Dad, what is that one?", asked the son as he pointed to another policy. "That's homeowners insurance, son." "If a tornado, hurricane, fire, or something else happens to the house, we are covered." The son points to a third policy. "That's health insurance," answered the Father. "If the family gets sick, it covers the bills."

The son points to the last policy. "That's life insurance." "If something happens to me, and I die, you and your mother will be taken care of." The son said, "I see all these policies, but Daddy, what about your soul?" The Father said, "My soul?" The son, said, "We read in CCE where Jesus said, "What does it profit a man, if he gains the whole world and loses his soul?" (Mark 8:36).

### SECOND SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME (B)

January 14, 2024

Jesus turned and saw them following Him and said to them, "What are you looking for?" John 1:38

The son asked a straight-forward question, "Daddy, is your soul covered?" The Father wanted to know how he could get his soul covered. It's through the Lamb of God, which John the Baptist introduced in today's Gospel (John 1:36). The Blood of the Lamb cleanses and covers our soul.

Many voices are speaking to us and wanting us to respond. In the First Reading (1 Samuel 3:3-10, 19) Samuel (while he was sleeping in the temple) thought Eli the priest and the Judge of Israel was calling him when it was God calling him. Samuel's readiness to serve was evidenced by his swift response to Eli. Samuel "was not familiar with the Lord" and did not recognize God's voice (I Samuel 3:7). We have got to learn the voice of the Lord. I don't have the television on when I prepare for a homily, because I don't want to hear too many voices. I just want to hear the one voice of the Shepherd.

When a quarterback puts their hands



over the sides of their helmet, it is known as **muffling**".

It's a technique used to block out external noise and improve their ability to hear their coach (the only voice that matters). Jesus speaks to us first, "What are you looking for?" Our response should be, "I am looking for and have found the Messiah (the Christ); the one who can cover and save my soul!






