EASTER SUNDAY OF THE RESURRECTION OF THE LORD (B)

March 31, 2024

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

Happy Easter Sunday of the Resurrection of the Lord! Jesus Christ has risen from the dead! This announcement resounds in the Church throughout the Christian world together with the singing of 'Alleluia, He is alive forever in our midst'. This Good News of Jesus Christ has been lit like the new flame we ignited on Saturday, the Holy night of the Easter Vigil; in the night of a world that faces crucial challenges, due to war, politics, racism and all the trials that impede our life of humanity. The light of Christ shines brightly in our hearts.

At Easter, we must be grateful because we are able to gather as a family to celebrate our Lord's Resurrection, and that becomes the reason for our joy; a joy that has to be contagious among our brothers and sisters, because it has to make us less fearful. It is a "contagious happiness", which is transmitted from heart to heart, because every human heart awaits this Good News of the Resurrection. It is the attitude of hope we all waited for on our Lenten journey: "My Lord and my God", Hope have truly risen! "He is not a magic formula that makes problems disappear. 


