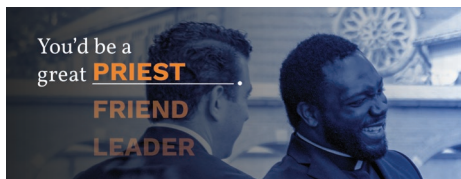

## **EASTER SUNDAY OF THE RESURRECTION OF THE LORD <sup>(B)</sup>**

**March 31, 2024**

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

Happy Easter Sunday of the Resurrection of the Lord! Jesus Christ has risen from the dead! This announcement resounds in the Church throughout the Christian world together with the singing of 'Alleluia, He is alive forever in our midst'. This Good News of Jesus Christ has been lit like the new flame we ignited on Saturday, the Holy night of the Easter Vigil; in the night of a world that faces crucial challenges, due to war, politics, racism and all the trials that impede our life of humanity. The light of Christ shines brightly in our hearts.

At Easter, we must be grateful because we are able to gather as a family to celebrate our Lord's Resurrection, and that becomes the reason for our joy; a joy that has to be contagious among our brothers and sisters, because it has to make us less fearful. It is a "contagious happiness", which is transmitted from heart to heart, because every human heart awaits this Good News of the Resurrection. It is the attitude of hope we all waited for on our Lenten journey: "My Lord and my God", Hope have truly risen! "He is not a magic formula that makes problems disappear. We do understand that the resurrection of Christ is the victory of love over the root of evil, a victory that does not "pass over" suffering and death, but goes beyond them, opening a path in the abyss, transforming evil in good, a distinctive sign of the power of God." (Pope Francis, Easter message 2020).

As a parish, in the midst of this Easter joy, I want to remind you that this Easter celebration is reflected in our faith commitment, along with an increase of love for St Francis Xavier Church and its family. That being said, we know that some parishioners still have not returned to in-person Mass, and we pray to God for them, because we know it is difficult to get back in our routine as before the pandemic, we must encourage them to come celebrate. However, Jesus has risen, and it is time to return home, it is time to overcome our fears. It is time to begin to enjoy our sacramental life together and to begin to re-invigorate SFX parish activities and ministries. I think it is important to reflect on our baptismal commitment, that commitment must be reflected in active participation in the call to discipleship. We need more lectors, extraordinary ministers of Holy Communion, and more altar servers, etc. We have to rise with the Lord and begin to strengthen our parish more and let our ministries flourish again.

I also invite everyone to congratulate our brothers and sisters in faith who received the sacraments of initiation at the Easter Vigil. It is a reason for joy because our spiritual family now has more members. Let us also congratulate and welcome the brothers and sisters who received the sacrament of confirmation and who will make their profession of faith and have full communion with us in the Catholic faith.

Finally, I would like to take the opportunity this Easter to thank all those volunteers of our parish: ushers, lectors, servers, extraordinary ministers, sacristans and musicians, who in communion with the parish staff, have made a great efforts so that our liturgies on these special days of Holy Week and all year is done beautifully and with great respect; know that you are all very important to me and have a very important place in my heart.

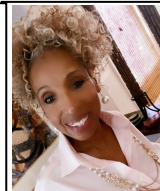
