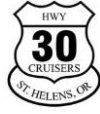




Highway 30 Cruisers Scholarship Application

Application Requirements

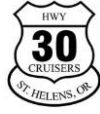
1. **Extra- Curricular Form-** Focus on achievements, academic awards and community involvement or volunteer work.

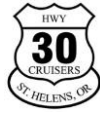
