In the centeris the image of St. Benedict. In his right hand he holds the Cross, the Christian symbol of salvation. In his left hand is his Rule for Monasteries (The Rule of St. Benedict.)

Inscribed around St. Benedict on both the right and left margins-

"May his presence protect us in the hour of death."

On a pedestal to the **right** of St. Benedict-

is a pitcher containing a deadly mixture of wine and poison. It is a representation of an attempted assassination against him, by monks under his spiritual direction. These lukewarm monks had found St. and decided to do away with blessing, as St. Benedict made the sign of the Cross over the pitcher, it shattered as if struck by a stone.

Juxtaposed to St. Benedict on both sides-"The Cross of the Holy Father Benedict"

Inscribed around the Cross on the left margin are these letters: S.M.Q.L.I.V.B.-

drink that poison yourself.'

Inscribed around the Cross on the right margin are these letters: V.R.S.N.S.M.V.-
