20 Ways Kids Can Help Make The Community A Better Place For Everyone by: Tanni Haas Ph.D.

November 13 is World Kindness Day, a great occasion to teach your kids the value of caring for the local community in which you live, especially those community members who can't care as well for themselves.

Here are 20 practical suggestions on what they can do:

Visit sick kids at the hospital. This is a wonderful gesture during the holidays or school breaks where everyone else is having fun.

Donate clothing and food to a homeless shelter. That will teach your kids the value of giving to those much less fortunate than themselves.

Help senior citizens learn to use technology, like how to search the internet, send emails, and navigate their smartphones, so they can better communicate with family and friends.

Offer to paint a less wellmaintained house in the neighborhood. There's always that one house that could use some sprucing up. Help coach a sports team with younger kids. This can be any sport they are good at or just like playing.

Assist senior citizens by helping them with their groceries or running errands around town.

Ask the library if they need tutors for younger kids in reading, writing, and basic math.

Volunteer for a clean-up day at a park. It's needed in many places and a lot of fun to do, too.

Help out at charity shops. These shops rely on volunteers and can always use another helping hand.

Visit the residents at a nursing home or assisted living facility. Many residents get less visits from family and friends than most people realize.

Organize a back-to-school supplies drive for kids whose families have fallen on hard times.



Contact a school to see if they need a homework tutor for its after-school program. Sometimes, kids can explain things to other kids in a way that's more relatable and makes more sense than adults.

Help care for the animals at the animal shelter. There's nothing like giving a little love to an abandoned dog or cat.

Organize a community gettogether at the community center. This could be a movie screening, a dance, or a group activity that encourages collaboration and bonding.

Donate books such as textbooks and test prep manuals to local schools.

Walk the dogs for neighbors who are injured, sick or otherwise unable to exercise their pets with daily outdoor walks.

Help out at a community garden planting flowers, vegetables, weeding, watering or just helping with upkeep and maintenance.

Volunteer at a soup kitchen. Many people do this at Thanksgiving or during the holidays, but the need is there all year round.

Read books or newspapers to the visually impaired.

Help senior citizens with seasonal tasks like raking leaves in the fall, shoveling snow in the winter, or mowing the grass in the summer.

Chronic absenteeism is defined as missing roughly 10% of the school year (about 18 days) and can predict lower reading scores by 3rd grade — a potential indicator of academic struggles in the future.

Top Tips for Parents:

After-School Appointments: Schedule appointments (like doctor or dentist visits) outside of school hours whenever possible.

Avoid In-Session Activities: Refrain from planning extracurricular activities during school hours.

Weigh the Pros and Cons: If an activity requires your child to be absent from school, consider the educational value against the lost instructional time.

Weekend Rejuvenation: Allow some free and unstructured time during weekends. It's essential for refreshing young minds and bodies.

Utilize School Holidays: The district calendar offers various days off. Use these breaks to plan activities and experiences outside the educational setting.





How To Prevent Your Kids From Becoming Stressed Tanni Haas, Ph.D.

November 1 is National Stress Awareness Day, a great occasion to consider what you can do to prevent your kids from becoming stressed. While low levels of stress are normal, stress can be damaging to your kids' physical, mental, and emotional health if it comes in high doses and persists over time. If that's the case, what can you do to prevent your kids from becoming overwhelmed by high levels of stress? Experts agree on the following points:

Take Good Care of Yourself – and Model Stress-Free Behaviors

It might sound counter-intuitive, but the first and most important thing is to take good care of yourself and try not to get stressed. "Stress is really contagious," says child psychotherapist Lynn Lyons, the author of Anxious Kids, Anxious Parents. "When parents are stressed out, kids are stressed out." Try to stay calm at all times and model stress-free behaviors to your kids. "Just like flight attendants advise adult passengers to put on their own oxygen masks before assisting others," says child psychologist Dr. Jamie Howard, "parents need to attend to their own physical and emotional needs to be able to best support their children." This means that you should avoid being tired or hungry for prolonged periods of time, and that you should seek emotional support from other adults when needed. "If you take care of

yourself and schedule time for your own needs," says professor of child psychology Dr. Amy Przeworski, "your child will learn that self-care is an important part of life. Children learn behaviors from watching their parents. So when you think about your child's psychological well-being think about your own as well."

Educate Your Kids about Stress: What It Is and How to Recognize It

Educate your kids about stress what it is and how to recognize it. Mrs. Lyons says it's important that you teach your kids "to understand their own bodies and the physiology of stress." Specifically, kids need to learn to tell the difference between normal and stressed reactions to what's happening to them. "While it's normal for a child's stomach to feel jumpy on the first day of school," says Mrs. Lyons, "leaving class because their stomach hurts or waking up repeatedly with a headache is a sign there's too much going on." Child psychotherapist Katie Hurley, the author of The Happy Kids Handbook, agrees: "To help your child connect the dots, draw the outline of a body and pinpoint different places where stress can cause problems." Explain to your kids all the common physical symptoms of stress, including backaches, headaches, neck aches, and stomachaches, and help them see where and how they react when they are stressed. As Mrs. Hurley puts it, "the more kids understand

the connection between symptoms and stress, the better able they will be to seek help."

Help Your Kids Become More Resilient

Besides teaching your kids how to recognize stress, also try to make them more resilient towards it. One useful technique is to teach your kids to take a couple of deep breaths when they are in a stressful situation. "Taking deep breaths can actually have a physiological effect on the body," says licensed mental health counselor Janice Halloran, the author of The Coping Skills for Kids Workbook. "When you're stressed, your body goes into fight, flight or freeze mode and your breathing automatically gets more shallow. To trick your body into getting back to a more restful state, take deep breaths." It's also useful to practice relaxation techniques with your kids. Dr. Przeworski recommends teaching your kids to imagine themselves somewhere relaxing. like the beach or in a backyard hammock, and then imagining all "the sounds, smells, and sensations associated with the image."

You can help make your kids more stress-resilient by encouraging them to confront their fears head on instead of shying away from them. Licensed psychotherapist Amy Morin, the author of 13 Things Mentally Strong Parents Don't Do, makes this important point with the example of elevators. If your kid is afraid of elevators and you always

suggest taking the stairs instead, you are essentially teaching your kid that s/he must be too fragile to take the elevator: "They grow up thinking, 'I'm not a capable person. If I'm afraid of something, I shouldn't do it. My parents don't believe in me, why should I believe in myself"? Once again, kids model what their parents do. "If children are surrounded by adults who model resilience," says child psychologist Dr. Lyn O'Grady, "through their own behaviours as well as by explicitly teaching and practicing the social and emotional skills, they will be more likely to develop resilience themselves."

Cultivate Stress-Free Activities

Finally, cultivate stress-free activities for your kids to do whenever they feel like they are about to get stressed. Mrs. Hurley suggests that parents create "stress-free zones" or "relaxation centers" in the home where kids can engage in their favorite activities. Similarly, Mrs. Lyons recommends that parents encourage their kids to engage in activities that are characterized by "pure play" - with no winners or losers, no particular end goal, and therefore no pressure to perform or reason to get stressed, such as outdoor sports like bike riding, hiking, and running.
