The deity of Christ is a fundamental principle of the Christian faith. If Jesus isn't God, everything that you believe about the Bible is a lie and we're all fools for following Him.

But it is easy to see from Scripture that Christ is the same as the Father - existing before the beginning, Lord over our present, and securing our eternal future.
