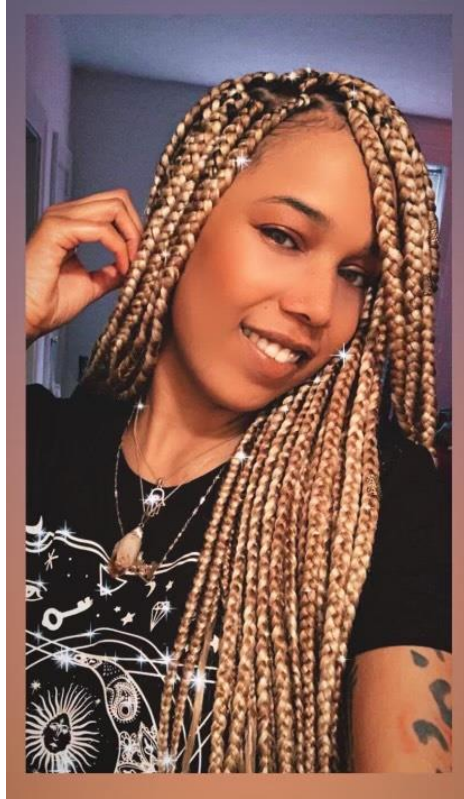

Obituary

Neurloni Katrell Hall, affectionately known as “Loni”, was a caring and spiritual soul whose life was lived with delightful cheerfulness. Her infectious laugh, sensitive nature, and loving heart connected warmly with many. Loni left this world suddenly on October 14, 2023, at age 32.

Born to Pamela E. Winfield and the late Charles R. Hall, Jr. on November 11, 1990, Loni lived her youth in Manhattan, NY. She resided in her adult years in the neighboring Garden State of New Jersey. There, she met her devoted fiancé and partner of six years, Alisha Sims.

Loni attended P.S.19 Asher Levy in Manhattan, NY. She also attended Marta Valle High School and Empire Beauty School.

Loni’s career included being an assistant manager for ABRS Check Cashing service in Brooklyn, NY. During the latter part of Loni’s career, she dedicated her services to the Newark Airport as a ClearMe Ambassador. In addition to that, she enjoyed being an Amazon influencer.

Like being wrapped in the warm blanket of her youth, family for Loni was reassurance. The uniquely close relationship she shared with her sisters was visible, unshakeable, mutually supportive, and loving.
