

The Bocce Spring leagues are coming to an end. Wednesday morning, Wednesday afternoon, and Raffa will end in May.

Dan DeNardi will host a mid-season tournament on Saturday, May 11 with our Monday Night teams vs Thursday Night Park and Recreation teams.

The IACC and the Golden State Bocce Club will host the United States Bocce Federation Western Sector 4-Person Open Tournament on Saturday, May 18 (see page 10). This will be a fundraiser for the USBF Western Sector California clubs.

On Friday, May 24, 34 students from the Italian class at South San Francisco High School will be coming to the courts to learn how to play bocce and on Saturday, May 25 there will be an Al Saco 4-Women Tournament which is always a lot of fun (see page 11).
