

**CHAPTER 523
Minor's Curfew**

523.01 CURFEW.

(a) No parent, guardian or person having the custody of a minor under the age of fourteen years old shall permit any such minor to be on any street, alley, or public way between the hours of 9:30 p.m. and 5:00 a.m. the following day.

(b) No parent, guardian or person having the custody of a minor fourteen or fifteen years old shall permit such minor to be on any street, alley or public way between the hours of 10:00 p.m. and 5:00 a.m. the following day.

(c) No child sixteen or seventeen years old shall be upon the streets, alleys or public ways of the Village between the hours of 11:00 p.m. and 5:00 a.m. the following day.

(d) The provisions of this section shall not apply when any of the following conditions exist:

- (1) Such minor is actually accompanied by a parent, guardian or person having custody of such minor or by a person of full age who has been specifically designated by such parent, guardian or person having custody to accompany such minor at that particular time.
- (2) Such minor, incident to his own actual attendance, is traveling promptly, directly and without stopping enroute, between such minor's home and the place of a service, program, activity or event which is sponsored for, or by a religious or educational organization, or a meeting of Boy or Girl Scouts.
- (3) Such minor is traveling promptly, directly and without stopping enroute, between his or her home and his or her regular and lawful place of employment or elsewhere with knowledge and permission of a parent or guardian.

- (4) Such minor is traveling promptly, directly and without stopping enroute, between his or her home and a theater or place of publicly supervised recreation at which he or she will be or has been in attendance. Wherever any such minor is on the streets or public ways under conditions as above defined unlawful, it shall be deemed that such minor is there with permission of his or her parent, parents, guardian or person having custody of such minor.

(e) Whoever violates this section is guilty of a minor misdemeanor.
