
SAFETY IS ALWAYS OUR NUMBER ONE PRIORITY

TRIP SAFETY

Our safety precautions

- All our staff are background checked and safety trained
- Our UK local staff are all UK educational professionals with over 30 years of experience
- Each trip has a First Aid trained expert
- Accommodation and food is both chosen with safety as the first priority
- Each trip also has a bilingual Chinese guide so that students can use Chinese in emergency situations
- Our staff to student ratio is a minimum of 10:1 AT ALL TIMES, and usually is around 7:1
- Our Chinese staff all pass stringent background checks

All competent UK summer schools and educational instructions have a designated safeguarding lead, whose main job is to always monitor the safety of students and ensure all proper planning has taken place prior to the trip commencing. Experienced Health & Safety expert, and previous human resource expert in local government, with worldwide Girl's Guide qualifications, Wendy is our safety lead.

EDUCATION CONTENT

Our trip is expertly designed to give students an insight into a variety of different majors connected to Business. This adventure will help students discover in which specialist area their true interest may lie and set them down a path of future discovery and preparation for university applications. It is hoped that after this trip students are able to consider a greater variety of potential majors and are focused on exploring which specific area of Business they may wish to study at university.



What is a workshop?

Workshops are interactive ways for students to learn, giving students a chance to actively engage in a specific project. For this trip we have partnered with a variety of famous UK sites to offer workshops (normally only accessible to native British students) to our students. This gives them a unique insight into UK education, offering a British style approach to learning and exploring the UK.

Our trip is also designed as an immersive English environment, meaning that students ' English level is expected to rapidly improve over the 12 days.





ACCOMMODATION

Our trip is based in London, with students staying in hotel accommodation during their stay in twin bedrooms (two of the same sex students sharing). Students will always be accompanied in their hotel by our two local guides and our bilingual Chinese guide, with a minimum staff ratio of 1:10. Our London base gives us access to Oxford, Cambridge and the most famous UK museums, based in the capital.



All included

All food is included in our trip price, with students having three meals a day with our local team. Any restaurant visited is first checked for safety by our local team.

Breakfast: Consists of an international buffet at our London based hotel

Lunch: Will be at different restaurants and health food markets each day, with students having a degree of choice, based around location

Dinner: Students will vote between 3 options each day to maximize student choice

In all our trips we aim to keep a flexible approach to food, so that we can customize the specific restaurants we visit around real-time student feedback. This Is decided with students voting between a set list of options for the next day each evening so that we can customize food choice and provide as much personalized choice around student needs as possible, to maximize student enjoyment.

Daily Overview

What happens each day of your 12 day UK adventure?

Welcome Dinner

Students will meet our bilingual team at the airport in China, before flying together to the UK. After landing in the UK, we will be greeted by our local UK team, waiting to pick us up at the airport and introduce themselves over a delicious welcome dinner as students are given time to get to know our team, and settle in to begin their UK adventure tomorrow.





DAILY OVERVIEW Day 1

Students will meet our UK Business Trip team leaders, Wendy & Mark when they land in the UK.

LONDON'S FINANCIAL DISTRICT

Today serves as our introduction to the UK's economic capital and central bank as we explore both the city itself and the financial policy of the central bank.





In the afternoon we will have a guided tour of the Financial District of London, exploring the commercial heart of the city. As part of this we will visit the Bank of England. At this interactive museum we will explore the Central Bank's role in regulating a nation's economy and be introduced to the workings of the UK's stock exchange and fiscal policy.



DAILY OVERVIEW Day 2









In the morning we will have a tour of London, seeing the home of 3 of the G5 universities, LSE, UCL and Imperial, as well as the Houses of Parliament, Big Ben, Downing Street, Tower Bridge and Hyde Park.





AM: Human Resource Management: In the morning session students will learn about managing large-scale teams in business and work generally. Heather will explore the realities of managing teams, and what Human Resource Management entails.

PM: Financial Management: In the afternoon session students will learn about budgeting for large scale projects, with Heather using real world case studies and her experience.

Heather is a successful businesswoman and entrepreneur, who has managed large teams of people and budgets totaling millions of pounds for organizations. She is an expert in Human Resources, financial management, and marketing. Since retiring she has launched her own business and is a prominent business lecture at many famous UK company training sessions.





BUSINESS LECTURES

After an academic day studying financial and human resource management, students will be able to relax with some British culture in the evening as they explore the world-famous British Museum. The British Museum is home to famous artefacts such as the Rosetta Stone and Yonger Memnon. Students will be able to use their photography skills to take beautiful photos of the artefacts and be introduced to the museum by our local guide.





DAILY **OVERVIEW** DAY 3

Business in Action

Students will see the transformation of the Millennium Dome into the 02 Arena, exploring how real-world businesses can alter function. This practical lesson continues as a Fortune 500 senior leader gives a career talk to students in the afternoon, about the realities of working in the Business world



In the morning, we will visit the famous 02 arena, where students will take part in the 'Climb the 02' experience to see beautiful views of London before completing a business exercise, led by our business expert Mark Walker, designed in partnership with the 02 arena.



In the afternoon students will have a special guest lecture from an experienced employee in a Fortune 500 company. The class will be a seminar, with students introduced to the realities of working in business, and able to ask questions.

DAILY OVERVIEW DAY 4

TATE




In the evening students will visit the famous Tate Britain, home to British Art dating back to the Tudor era, including work by Turner & Blake. Students will be able to see a variety of European art, which is often quirkier and more unique than that on display at other galleries in London.

BUSINESS VISIT

Today we continue our exploration of real world business as we visit the factory of 'Fashion Enter,' to explore how the international business works. We will have both a factory visit, and a specially organized workshop by their management team.

Morning

In the morning and early afternoon students will visit 'Fashion Enter' for an exclusive tour and workshop. This will explore technology in the digital world, as well as the realities of costing in manufacturing. Students will combine both the factory tour and the academic content of the workshop to understand the connections between academic theory and business reality.



DAILY OVERVIEW DAY 5

In the afternoon students will have a special guest lecture, exploring Business Management, detailing the techniques used by big businesses to ensure success, and the academic theories of how to succeed in business planning.

DAILY OVERVIEW DAY 6



Project Management Lecture

Our afternoon lecture is on the topic of project management and management consultancy. Our guest lecturer will introduce working in the two areas, detailing the skills needed, the recruitment process, and introducing the big companies involved in this area. Isobel will outline a day in the life working in these two areas, as well as explaining what these jobs involve, with real-world case studies to help students understand this area that is an in-demand area for graduates from elite universities.

Museum of Brands Workshop: Customer Profiling

In the morning, students will visit the Museum of Brands, where our partners at the museum will run a workshop on customer profiling. This will help students understand how big data is used in analyzing customer trends and identifying potential target customers to buy their products. For students who are interested in studying either Marketing or Data Analysis this is a good introductory lecture given by professionals from the museum's team.

Students will also visit the museum and explore the history of branding, seeing how marketing techniques and strategies have changed over time, and learning how big businesses use marketing strategies to attract customers.

UNIVERSITY OF CAMBRIDGE



College tour & punting Students will first take part in a walking tour of Cambridge university, gaining understanding of the college system of the university and its history, before taking part in the traditional recreational activity of punting on the river.



OXFORD UNIVERSITY

Oxford university is the oldest continuously running university in the Western world, dating its history back to 1101. It is a traditional university, with many different colleges making up the university. Most British Prime Ministers and leaders are graduates of Oxford University, and it is easily the most famous university in the Western World.






In the morning students will visit the famous BMW-Mini factory in Oxford for a special guided tour of the factory. This will help students understand the manufacturing process, and how such a large global business uses strategies such as 'Just in Time' to maximize profits. Students will be accompanied by our expert team at all times, as the guided tour is led by BMW Mini expert employees.

In the afternoon our expert local team, including local Oxford graduates will guide the students around the city, giving students an insider's guide to life as an Oxford student. Students will also visit the famous Balliol college (used in Harry Potter and the Chamber of Secrets).

DAILY OVERVIEW DAY 9

Morning:

In the morning, retired FTSE 100 Business Senior Leader and ICE in-house expert, Mark, will lead students through a factory simulation exercise, helping students understand supply chain management, and cost control.

Afternoon:

After lunch Benji Johnson will guide students in how to write a business plan, and introduce their task for the next day, explaining what a 'Dragon's Den' pitch is, and discuss the challenges of attracting investment for business projects.


Evening:

DAILY OVERVIEW DAY 10



In the morning, Benji will be on hand to help groups as they put the final touches to their business pitches ready to present to our panel of judges. Students will be expected to prepare a SWOT analysis, cash flow projections, and have a clear understanding of their target customer, combining their knowledge from our trip.



After lunch it is time for our Dragon's Den pitch as each group of students pitch their business plan to our team of expert judges, with a special prize for the winning team. Students will have 30 minutes to present their business idea and be expected to be able to answer questions from potential investors.



In the late afternoon we celebrate the end of our presentations with our trip to the London Eye. This adventure gives students beautiful views of London and allows them to explore the South Bank of the River Thames as they have some well-earned time to relax.



DAILY OVERVIEW Day 11 For our final day we will visit Warner Brother Studios where the magic of the Harry Potter film series is brought to life. Students will be able to explore the special effects used to create famous movies, as well as explore some of the original sets used in the filming of the world-famous Harry Potter movies.

In the evening, students will have one final chance to explore London, before saying goodbye to the city.
