Call to Order: 7:00 pm

Verification of Posting

Previous meeting minutes:

August 14, 2023 Monthly meeting minutes were read; motion to accept by Mitch, seconded by Scott. August 29, 2023 Special Board meeting minutes were read; motion to accept by Scott, seconded by Mitch.

Treasurer:

Monthly report including settlements and liquor license payments received with a motion to accept by Scott and seconded by Mitch

Monthly Balance Report:

Report shows 2023 actual expenditures and includes anticipated projections for total 2023 budget expectations. During the Special Board meeting on Aug 29th, projections were discussed and classification changes were activated to ensure monies were properly accounted.

Report shows the town is projected to run \$4,350 over budget but adjustments may be made at year end.

Note, over budget does not mean dollars not available. Money in other accounts such as White Pine Cemetery or ARPA may be available for float and can be paid back.

Website is up to date – added pop-up to front page discussion on Warner Lake Rd construction.

2024 DRAFT Budget:

DRAFT budget shows base Dept of Rev revenue projections only, giving a 0.5% increase.

State funded road loan levy of 165K from 2023 is paid so it is gone in 2024 causing 38% drop in levy. Intergovernmental income will increase due to increased shared revenue and 2 TRIP road programs and a few others.

Overall, if town doesn't do anything, 2024 income and expenditures will both increase 3.82 % over 2023

Discussion of potential roads projects and further expenses.

- Blacktopped roads need to be chip sealed total of 3 miles. Expected expense at \$25,000 \$27, 000 / mile = \$74,000 \$81,000.
- Williams RD 8/10th of road \$146 K will be paid by grant but needs to be paid up front
- Warner Lake road 2.1 miles 3 inches blacktop \$300 K

Opened a discussion about options of how to pay for these future projects, either a loan or a raising the levy.

Points made during a discussion of a potential \$150,000 "base" levy increase:

- Last year a motion was passed to raise levy \$75K but did not choose to enforce, due to loan to finish Culbertson Rd.
- The increase will have minimal impact vs 2023 due to \$165,000 loan being paid
- Levy increase is permanent, never lowers. Potential of overfunding in future
- Loan amounts one time, potential to lower levies after done.
- Board still has option to take a loan if needed
- Option of a lower levy (\$75K \$100K \$120K etc.) vs \$150,000
- Levy increase % in last 2 years much higher than inflation and SSA amounts.
- School Board and City taxes also increasing
- Resident asked for a better pro/con discussion of loan vs levy vs no projects in following meetings
- If raise levy \$150,000 it will be a 113.5% increase over the amount approved by the DOR

Darwyn asked opinion poll of residents

Chairman Darwyn made motion to pass Resolution #2023-002 for a levy increase of \$150,000, Supervisor Mitch Coyour seconded.

Verbal vote taken, Darwyn & Mitch voted aye, Scott opposed with nay vote. Board resolution passed.

Resolution # 2023-002 signed by Board tonight

Special Town Electors meeting, with proper posting periods, will follow to pass resolution.

Budget Approval meeting with proper posting will follow. Dates of both to be determined and posted.

Road items:

- Replaced drive chain on rear axle of grader. Doug and Mitch able to repair.
- Dump Truck hydraulic cylinder broke. Could be very costly but solution to repair was found. Expected \$5,000 cost, repair to be completed before year end.
- Road ATV signs haven't been put up yet. Map and stakes provided.
- Mowing & fixing pot holes
- Backhoe back to shop

Darwyn asked town to cover his expenses to attend WTA convention on Oct $22^{nd} - 24^{th}$. It was granted via motion by Scott, seconded by Mitch

Whereas, the State of Wisconsin has imposed levy limits on town, village, city, and county levies for 2021 and thereafter under Wis. Stat. § 66.0602;

Whereas, Wis. Stat. § 66.0602 limits the allowable local levy for 2023 to a percentage increase of no more than the greater of (a) zero percent of the 2023 payable 2024 adjusted actual levy as calculated under the state's levy limit law* or (b) a percentage equal to the percent change in equalized value due to net new construction less improvements removed which for the Town of LaFollette is 0.498%;

Whereas, the town board of the Town of LaFollette, Burnett County, believes that for the 2023 tax levy (to be collected in 2024) it is in the town's best interest to exceed the state levy limit as described above by a greater percentage than 0.423%;

Whereas, the Town of LaFollette's 2023 payable 2024 adjusted actual tax levy was \$131,905, and further whereas the state law would limit this year's increase to \$132,562, for a total allowable town tax levy before adjustments for 2023 (to be collected in 2024) of \$132,432;

Whereas, the State of Wisconsin has imposed levy limits on town, village, city, and county levies for 2023 and thereafter under Wis. Stat. § 66.0602;

Whereas, Wis. Stat. § 66.0602 limits the allowable local levy for 2023 to a percentage increase of no more than the greater of (a) zero percent of the 2022 payable 2023 adjusted actual levy as calculated under the state's levy limit I:w or (b) a percentage equal to the percent change in equalized value due to net new construction less improvements removed, which for the Town of LaFollette is **0.498%**;

Whereas, the town board of the Town of LaFollette, Burnett County, believes that for the 2023 tax levy (to be collected in 2024) it is in the town's best interest to exceed the state levy limit as described above by a greater percentage than **0.498%**;

Whereas, the Town of LaFollette's 2022 payable 2023 adjusted actual tax levy was \$131,905, and further whereas the state law would limit this year's increase to \$527, for a total allowable town tax levy after adjustments for 2023 (to be collected in 2024) of \$132,432;

THEREFORE, the town board of the Town of LaFollette, Burnett County does hereby resolve and order as follows:

- 1. The town board supports an increase in the town tax levy for 2023 that will exceed the amount allowed by the state levy limit.
- 2. The town board directs that the question of increasing the allowable town tax levy for 2023 (to be collected in 2024) by 113.27%, which would increase the town levy by \$150,000, for a total tax levy (after adjustments) of \$282,432 shall be placed on the agenda for the special town meeting to be held on October 16, 2023.
