All Exhibits Released: Monday, June 17, 2024, 10:00am - 6:00pm. All unclaimed exhibits and awards will be recycled or donated to a charitable organization after Monday, June 17.

ADULT BUTTER CAKE CONTEST

The entries will be judged according to the following:

Originality, Practicality, Economy, and Neatness. All entries for these special awards must have the statement "*MADE WITH BUTTER*" entered in the description field online. Butter will be awarded to the top five overall winners. **No results will be given out by phone, text or email.**

Rules:

- 1. Butter must be one of the principal ingredients of the recipe.
- 2. The recipe must contain at least one other dairy product (milk, cream, etc.) in cake, filling or frosting.
- 3. The recipe for the cake must accompany each entry and be printed on a recipe card. Must be specific and eligible for inclusion in cookbook.
- 4. The recipe and the right to publish it with the name of the contestant becomes the property of California Dairies, Inc., or anyone to whom they assign this right.
- 5. Entries will be made on the regular entry form, properly completed. Any errors in entering or in compliance with the above rules might be cause for disqualification.
- 6. Winners will be selected from the 1st place entries in each class. An exhibitor is not eligible for more than one award.

CALIFORNIA DAIRIES COOKIES CONTEST

Juniors, 4-H & FFA

AWARD: California Dairies, Inc. offers the following special awards for best cookies. All entries for these special awards will have the statement "made with butter" entered in the online system in each class entered. Juniors and 4-H will be judged together. '

1st place 15 pounds of butter 2nd place 10 pounds of butter 3rd place 5 pounds of butter

Limit: 1 entry per exhibitor

Rules:

- 1. The recipe for the cookies must accompany each entry to be printed on a regular recipe card.
- 2. Name, address and phone number must be on the recipe card.
- 3. Butter must be one of the principal ingredients of the recipe.
- 4. The recipe must contain at least one other dairy product (milk, cream, cheese, etc.). Eggs do not qualify.
- 5. The recipe and the right to publish it with the name of the contestant becomes the property of California Dairies, Inc. or anyone to whom they assign this right.
- 6. Substitution allowed only in the same class.
- 7. THE SAME RECIPE CANNOT BE ENTERED IN MORE THAN ONE CLASS.

- 1. Bar cookies
- 2. Butter (shaped with cookie press)
- 3. Drop cookies frosted
- 4. Drop cookies unfrosted
- 5. Fruit cookies
- 6. Refrigerator cookies
- 7. Nut cookies

- 9. Rolled Cookies-Frosted
- 10. Rolled Cookies- Unfrosted
- 11. Any Other Identify
