

Mr. Malek bought an air-conditioner for the Subject Child Margaret, that keeps the family home at a comfortable temperature. Currently, the home does not pose any danger to the children.

On 10/06/20, home visit, CPS observed Joe and Margaret interacting appropriately with no conflict. The children continue to interact appropriately with each other with minor conflict. The children were observed doing art and crafts that consists of colorful beads and strings. Subject Child Joe told CPS the Non-Respondent mother bought it for him and he is teaching his sister to make necklaces, bracelets and earrings. CPS observed mother and children interactions to be cordial and free of fear and intimidation. The children have always been observed free of suspicious marks and bruises on their faces, chest, backs, arms and feet.

School:

The child Joe was promoted and is attending a High School of his choice and is participating in remote learning currently. On 10/05/20, CPS confirmed with Joe's school guidance counselor, that he is participating remotely tentatively. The child Margaret continues to attend her elementary school and was promoted to Kindergarten. She currently is participating in blended learning, that is one week in-person classes and the next week is remote learning. On 09/24/20, CPS confirmed with Margaret's school counselor that she is participating in blended learning.

Medical:

The subject children Joe and Margaret are medically up to date. Their immunizations are up to date as well. On 09/15/20, subject child Margaret were seen for injury to her head, routine health exam And routine health maintenance, BMI (body mass index) pediatric, dietary and exercise counseling. Please note there were no concerns noted about Margaret growth (height and weight). Margaret was treated at Urgent care on 09/19/2020 for Acute pharyngitis. The Non- Respondent mother followed through with the Urologist for Margaret and the child is prescribed medication to treat UTI related issue. The Non-Respondent mother takes the children to their medical care and follow through with specialized referrals. ON HOLDING 3 TIME ISSUE

Services and referrals:

The non-respondent mother and children receives Preventive Services from CAMBA. They have been compliant and adhere to recommendations and suggestions. The non-respondent mother and subject child continue to be consistent with weekly therapy. On 10/01/20, CPS did outreach to each Psychotherapist providing therapy to the family. The Non-Respondent mother therapist stated, Ms. Ingolia continues to actively participate during sessions and is consistent. Margaret's therapist is now seeing the child independently and will provide a letter to the courts. The non-respondent mother is participating in a twelve weeks Parenting class and is set to graduate on 10/20/20.

To date, Mr. Malek has not done the imminent risk assessment. On 03/31/20, CPS provided Mr. Malek with mental health resources in his community as recommended by mental health consultant. Mr. Malek has not followed through with these referrals. CPS participated in two separate domestic violence consultation regarding this case, especially how to engage the respondent father around services and its benefits. CPS explored and engaged the father on services, especially supervised visitation through New York Society for prevention of cruelty to children (NYSPCC). Mr. Malek is not receptive to any type of services at this point. On 07/01/20, referral was given to the non-respondent mother, with recommendations after a domestic violence consultation on 06/26/20. The recommendations include individual/family counseling, with specialization in managing symptoms
