CPS explained that the SC need to sleep separate. BM stated that SC Joe can sleep on the sofa bed however, due to his size the sofabed is uncomfortable. CPS offered the suggestion that she and SC Margaret share the sofabed. BM stated that the sofabed is bad for her as well. CPS stated that she will have to buy a mattress pad for the sofabed. CPS explained that SC Joe will need to sleep on the sofabed. BM stated that she will have the SC sleep on the sofabed.

She stated that the man was very controlling and sometimes, he would take away the food in the home. The mother went to say that the man pushes them around whenever he wants.

The CPS asked the mother if the 4-year-old has ever been couched on what to say. The mother stated that the child saw so many abuse happened in the home when they were staying with her father. She stated that the child's father poured cold water on the child as a form of punishment when he thinks that the child was not listening to him. The mother also stated that the child witnessed the father shoving her whenever he was angry.

She stated that the father has supervised visitation with the child at the ACS field office. The mother stated that the ACS worker always argue with the father whenever they see each other.
