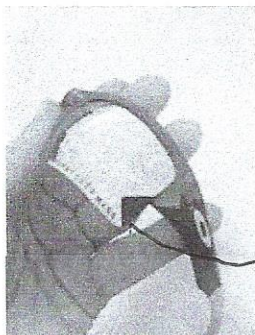

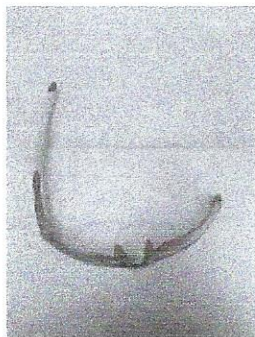

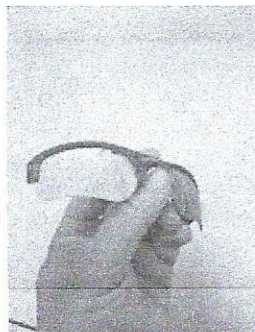

stroller/personal belongings in the waiting area while she attends an appointment on another floor. She was instructed to take all her belongings with her, text this writer of her whereabouts, and assure that she returned by the agreed upon time to pick up her daughter. She was reminded that CFS cannot be held responsible for any items left unattended. Ms. Ingoglia also told Mini prior to the April 22, 2019 visit, to not take toys from her father, saying "do you want us to get kicked out?" and the writer immediately told the mother not to talk to Mini like that as she is a child and they should not put Mini in the middle of the argument over toys and other items.

For the seventeen visits during this reporting period, Mr. Malek was always on time and patient when the mother was late, remaining at CFS until the child arrived. The visits were relatively similar in nature and can therefore be summarized. At each visit, Mini was excited to see her father, she screamed "DADDY!" and ran into his arms. The father brought food and other items for Mini such as a portable DVD player (the father purchased a second one after Mini took the first one home with her), clothes, hats, a watch, and toys. Mr. Malek also laid down blankets and towels in the visit room to "make it look more like home." Mini was not interested in the clothes offered by her father and constantly asked her father what toys he had brought her. Mr. Malek purchased any toy Mini asked for and excitedly gave them to her upon their arrival. For instance, a "Hungry Hungry Hippos" game reportedly took a long time to be delivered. Mini asked about the game for days and she was very happy and jumped around when it arrived. The father consistently asked Mini at the next visit if she still had the items he gave her at the previous one. He complained to this writer that the mother was "throwing the toys out, or Joe was breaking them" until redirected. When Mini said her sunglasses were lost, he bought her another pair, only to have the mother bring the first pair to the next visit. Mr. Malek incorporated other items into their play, as he brought old photo albums of when he was a child and talked to her about his childhood and places they have been together, and he would like to take her to. The father was very affectionate with Mini throughout the visit, as he hugged and kissed her often. Mini was affectionate towards the father as well. Mr. Malek brought

Is there a reason why you didn't put in your report that the second pair I bought her was given back broken the next day? And furthermore, that she said when I gave her the first pair that joe will take them from her and break them. He broke the heads off mommies dolls. She said.

I had to buy her a second pair of barbie dolls because she told me joe broke her first pair...as she said joe broke mommies.

Well, this is impossible. We had a visit on 3/20. The glasses were ordered on 3/25. We had a visit on 3/26 and they arrived on 3/27. There was no visit again until 3/29.

- *Does minnie go outside alone? No. So who's responsibility is it to safeguard the sunglasses? When minnie goes inside, the sunglasses come off and who's responsibility would it be to care for them for minnie? Her mother. So since I bought her several pocketbooks and 2 sunglass cases, how do they get lost in a living space that is supposedly so small? Furthermore, how come minnie always has to come back upstairs with a pathetic plastic bag with whatever she brings back home when she was given pocketbooks / sunglass cases for her things? This makes no sense.*
- *You would think that since the second pair was broken the next day, a little more care would be given for the first pair. Why is it that these sunglasses get lost and broken so quickly, exactly as my daughter claims?*
- *It is apparent that anything that has PERMANENCE from daddy, be it a watch, a sunglass case, pocketbook or sunglasses, especially when they say daddy luv's minnie on them, mysteriously disappear in a living space that is supposedly so very very small makes no sense whatsoever. I doubt if margaret spent 400 dollars on 2 sunglasses for minnie they would be gone so quickly.*
- *No more items from daddy in the email and approx 1800 minutes of lateness at cfs.*

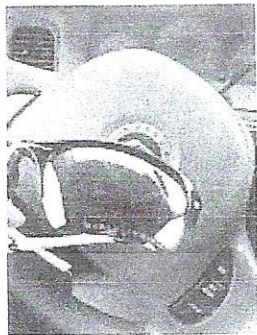
