Again, my advise is to just plan for the next one.

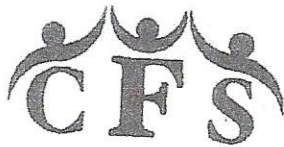

Comprehensive Family Services (CFS) is in receipt of Court Order dated October 22, 2018 directing that CFS conduct three, two-hour therapeutic visitation sessions, between Mr. Robert Malek, and his daughter, Margaret (Minnie) Michelle (age 4). As of the date of this report, one visit has occurred and two more are scheduled for January 21 and 29 from 9-11 am. The following report is respectfully submitted.

The first visit occurred on January 16, 2019 and was scheduled from 2:30 – 4:30 pm. Mr. Malek arrived 20 minutes early and Ms. Ingoglia and Margaret were 25 minutes late, citing train trouble. As soon as she saw this writer the child said, "I want to see Daddy!" and she came willingly with the undersigned to go see Mr. Malek. She was wearing a shirt with "Daddy loves me," printed on it, and seemed happy to show this writer. She seemed excited as noted in her jumping up and down as she waited for the elevator. Upon seeing Mr. Malek, Margaret ran to him and jumped into his arms. Mr. Malek said he was very happy to see her and that he misses her every day. The father brought numerous toys for his daughter, including Lego blocks, a small remote-control helicopter, and magic tracks. Mr. Malek also brought a large Paw Patrol pillow for his daughter to lay on while playing. Mr. Malek asked about Margaret's haircut and she replied that her hair was "all frizzy." Margaret was observed to appear relaxed and was easily engaged in play. She sat next to him on the floor

as they occupied themselves with the new items. Mr. Malek taught her about how to put the toys together and put the batteries in. Margaret laughed and screamed watching the toy helicopter fly around the room until it almost hit a light fixture and this writer told them they had to stop. The father brought ice cream, a tuna fish sandwich, and vitamin water for the child. Margaret, while eating the sandwich, ate a slice of a jalapeno pepper and told her father, "Daddy my mouth is burning." The father gave her some water and ice cream to try and soothe her and took the remaining jalapenos out of the sandwich. When Mr. Malek asked her if she wanted any more of the sandwich, she said "No thanks." Mr. Malek and Margaret then laid on the floor together and played with a toy cash register. The father encouraged Margaret to use her imagination as collaborative play ensued. Mr. Malek allowed Margaret to play with numerous toys at once, turning the visit room into disarray. Margaret then took her father's phone and played some games he had downloaded for her. This writer informed the father that they would have to clean up before the visit was over. Mr. Malek seemed upset to learn that because the mother was late, there could not be a full two-hour visit. He said that his daughter is the most important thing in his life and the case is secondary to being with her. This writer directed the father to not discuss such matters in front of the child and redirected his attention to Margaret. While playing with Lego blocks Margaret kept saying that she "couldn't build it." The father told her not to say that and to "believe in yourself," and "you can do anything." He told her to breathe and "take it easy" and Margaret was able to build what she wanted. The father offered praise to his daughter for not giving up. Throughout the visit the father was affectionate with Margaret, stroking her head and kissing her often. At 4:10 pm, the writer informed Mr. Malek and Margaret it was time to clean-up the room and put all the toys away. Margaret said she "wants to play with daddy," and Mr. Malek began to get upset, and putting his hands over his face. Margaret said, "I'm too scared to go," and "I want to play with the toys!" This writer asked Margaret what she is scared of and she replied, "I want to play with Daddy." She said she wanted to play with the toys and Mr. Malek began to cry and Margaret told her father she wanted to go and stay with him. Mr. Malek told her he knows this and that "in time [they] will have more time together." The father told her "if I could play with you I would but it is not me. [this writer] is telling me its time to put things away." This writer told the father that he needs to be more assertive with his daughter and have her help clean up. Each time she said "no," he put his hands to his face and began to cry. This writer told the father again,

it was time to clean-up, and he stated that he has nineteen minutes left. This writer told the father that there was a lot to clean up and he began to play a video of the song "Butterfly Kisses" for Margaret on his phone. At 4:27 pm the room was still not clean, and the father had his daughter in his lap. She kept saying she wanted to play and that she was "scared." This writer asked her again what she was scared of and she said, "I want to stay with daddy." Mr. Malek tried to tell her it was time to go, and each time she said "No," Mr. Malek asked Margaret to "work with him" and she said "No." At 4:35 pm the father was still pleading with the child and she began to cry that she "wants to stay with daddy." The father said that he loved her, and they would spend more time with each other very soon. Margaret and Mr. Malek both kept crying as this writer tried to separate the two to end the visit. This writer was able to pick Margaret up and began to carry her out to the elevators as Mr. Malek held on to her saying it was going to be OK. The father followed this writer as Margaret was carried away down the hallway, holding onto her arms and this writer. The undersigned told Mr. Malek he had to let go as the visit was over and she needed to return to her mother. Once by the elevators Margaret calmed down and this writer again asked her why she said she was scared. She said, "I want to stay with Daddy." When this writer told her that she had to go with her mother now she said "No, Daddy." The undersigned arrived at the mother at 4:45 pm with Margaret still whimpering, but when she realized she did not get a toy from her father she began to cry again. ^{mind reader} This writer told Margaret that the father will bring all the toys back on Monday and returned to the visit room where the father had begun to clean up. At approximately 5:00 pm the father left the building.

It should be noted that since the completion of the above described visit, Mr. Malek has contacted this writer and CFS Assistant Director Bettina Thomsen both by repeated phone calls and emails. In these communications, Mr. Malek has complained about the content of this writer's previous Court report and has offered suggestions of how the report should be amended. He made frequent reference to his belief that the mother wishes for the child to be dead and voiced his concern that this writer did not seem to be sufficiently alarmed by his allegations. Mr. Malek also offered to reply a video that he had played during his intake sessions as further evidence of the accuracy of his narrative. The father also sent emails related to the child's haircut and expressed his belief that the haircut was not appropriate for a girl and also mentioned that he had consulted with other females who concurred with his

view on this. He also mentioned that he did not believe the haircut to be appropriate for the winter weather. Lastly, Mr. Malek expressed his belief that CFS should schedule additional time for him to allow for his visit to be extended in the event that the mother is to arrive late again. This writer informed Mr. Malek that it was the expectation that both parties would arrive on time and that any delays would be relayed to the Court, and that CFS could not schedule additional time based on his predictions regarding the mother's behavior. As for the other concerns raised, Mr. Malek was redirected to discuss these with either his attorney, ACS, or the Court. In response, Mr. Malek replied "Lord Jesus please help my daughter and I."

CFS remains available to provide services as directed by the court and shall await further directives.

many things." When this was relayed to the father, he said he would speak with his attorney about it. One instance, when Mini tried to take home a bubble machine, the father said "[this writer] said we can't take that home." We talked with Mini about how she had just taken the exact same bubble machine home the day before and she should leave one for daddy to play with. This writer spoke with father about not making it one adult against the other, and instead suggested showing Mini that her father and this writer are on the same page. Ms. Ingoglia did however allow Mini to take home the "Hungry Hungry Hippos" game which was rather large. Whenever Mini would get upset at something, for example, not being able to go to the beach, or not being able to take home a toy, the father would put his face in his hands and tell Mini that it was "not Daddy's fault." Mr. Malek became emotional at the visits, one time he wept openly when reading a book to her and he cried when she was feeling ill and spent two entire visits sleeping. ^{NOT 20 MINUTE VISIT} At times, Mr. Malek would tear up as he sang along to the music as he stroked Mini's hair and back while she played. During a couple of visits Mini brought up cats and became upset that "Rainbow" and "Blueberry" had to be given away. Mr. Malek got visibly upset each time and would explain that Rainbow was too rough with Mini and Blueberry (which he referred to as Bear) was something "the mother did, and not [his] fault." This writer told him to compose himself in front of his daughter and to redirect her with one of the toys he brought, which he did. During the April 25, 2019 visit, while getting ready to leave Mini asked her father about "being nice to mommy and Joe, and not scaring them." The father became upset and put his head in his hands as Mini continued to say, "we all need to be nice, so Mommy and Joe don't get angry." This writer told her that everyone loves Mini and she does not have to worry about that. At one visit Mini asked for a doll house and Mr. Malek said it was a little big, but he would look into it by having this writer ask the mother. This writer asked the father not to give her a dollhouse, as the mother does not have space and she has told Mini she cannot take little gifts home, certainly not big ones. The father would benefit from setting limits for his daughter as opposed to entertaining her every wish and desire. When told she could not have the doll house, and Mini began to get upset the father also got upset and put his hands in his
