LEDC continues to engage with the LVVWD on water service for Laughlin. Recently LVVWD admitted that they can no longer service any additional growth. They are now using Storage constraints as the issue. The LEDC has communicated with them multiple times over the first half of 2023, and we are updating our <u>laughlinedc.org</u> website.

The LEDC has also engaged the Nevada Department of Environmental Protection for their assistance in resolving this water service issue. This is ongoing and updates will be posted on the LEDC website as things progress.

The LEDC will continue to engage with all parties to move this issue forward, provide for smart growth opportunities, and in time reignite the Casino SID project.

The Laughlin Bridge construction continues. Project is just a bit behind schedule. The LEDC monitors this construction for the benefit of the community.

The Southland Wet Utility design has yet to be addressed by the County. This study was first requested by the Laughlin Town Advisory Board in November 2017 with a resolution passed by the board. The LEDC raised the issue in October 2019.

We hope that with some new County Staff management that this request will be acted upon. Without it, the Southland properties along the new bridge connector road will have no plan for future development.


