Who's The Bride?

Some of the Pharisees came to Jesus and were saying that He should go away, saying that King Herod was wanting to kill Him. Luk 13:31

Many of the Children of Israel were willing to entertain the deceptions of these leaders having taken the seat of Moses; yet most of these religious leaders were belonging to Satan. Jesus said the scribes and the Pharisees had seated themselves in the chair of Moses. Mat 23:2.

From John Eight-thirteen we are seeing Jesus talking to the Pharisees, telling them the devil was their father. These Religious leaders were wanting to do the desires of the Devil and kill Jesus. Satan is the murderer from the beginning and does not stand in the truth because there is no truth in him. Whenever Satan speaks a lie, he speaks from his own nature, because he is a liar and the father of lies. Jhn 8:44

Despite the deceptions embraced by Israel in the times of Jesus walking the earth, there still remains the Promises for their full restoration and a kingdom enduring in peace for almost a thousand years. This will happen after the Rapture and the subsequent seven-year Tribulation.

When the Apostles had gathered together, they were asking Jesus, saying, "Lord, is it at this time You will be restoring the kingdom to Israel?" He said to them, "It's not for you to know times or epochs that the Father has fixed by His own authority. Act 1:6-7

Jesus was saying that Jerusalem was the city that kills the prophets and stones those sent to her! How often He wanted to gather the children of Israel together, just as a hen gathers her brood under her wings, and they would not have it! Therefore, their house was left to them desolate. Jesus/Eternal Savior said they will not see Him again until the time comes when they say, "BLESSED IS HE WHO COMES IN THE NAME OF THE LORD!" Luk 13:34-35

Jesus did make it clear to His Disciples/Apostles that there would definitely be an earthly kingdom for His twelve and the children of Israel.

So Jesus said to them, "Assuredly I say to you, that in the regeneration, when the Son of Man sits on the throne of His glory, you who have followed Me will also sit on twelve thrones, judging the twelve tribes of Israel. [Mat 19:28 NKJV]

Jesus also said the Apostles would be eating and drinking at His table in His kingdom. Luk 22:30

Despite overwhelming evidence of these things, The Great Harlot, claiming to be the Church, has sought to erase the memory of these things from our minds; murdering and oppressing the Jewish people throughout the ages. But the Apostle Paul is assuring us that God has a future for Israel despite every attempt of Satan's people to exterminate the Jew. And Jesus gives us a heads up regarding this murderous organization.

"They will make you outcasts from the synagogue, but an hour is coming for everyone who kills you to think that he is offering service to God.

[Jhn 16:2 NASB]

The word of God leaves us with no other conclusion other than God having a glorious future for the Jewish people after the times of the Gentiles/Church be Completed.

The Apostle Paul didn't want any true believers to be uninformed of this mystery--so that we would not be wise in our own estimation--that a partial hardening has happened to Israel until the times of the Gentiles are finished. After these times all Israel will be saved; just as it is written, "THE SAVIOR WILL COME FROM ZION, AND HE WILL REMOVE ALL UNGODLINESS FROM JACOB."
"THIS IS MY COVENANT WITH THEM, WHEN I TAKE AWAY THEIR SINS." Rom 11:25-27

Jehovah/The Eternal One declares that the days are coming when He will make a new covenant with the house of Israel and Judah. This is a different covenant than He made with their fathers in the day He took them out of the land of Egypt. Israel broke the first covenant even though their Eternal One was like a husband to them. After the times of the Gentiles God will make a new covenant with the house of Israel. At this time of the future, Jehovah will put His law on their hearts, and He will be their God, and they shall be His people. Jer 31:31-33

There are too many scriptures to list, indicative that God's people would suffer immensely at the hands of the Great Harlot; but would later be restored. The Great Harlot has always taught the destruction of Israel, never their restoration.

It will no longer be said of you, "Forsaken," Nor will your land any longer be referred to as being "Desolate"; But you will be called, "My delight is in her," And your land, "Married"; because The Eternal One delights in you, and to Him your land will be married. Just as a young man marries a virgin, so your sons will marry you. Just as the bridegroom rejoices over the bride, so your God will rejoice over you. ...Give (Jehovah) no rest until He establishes and makes Jerusalem the praise in the earth.

Isa 62:4-5, 7

Over and over We see prophecy of Jerusalem being completely restored to the nation of Israel; but the present Jerusalem was destined to be in bondage, and trampled by the Gentile nations:

This is metaphorically speaking, because these women are two covenants: one proceeding from Mount Sinai bearing children who are to be slaves; she is Hagar. Hagar is Mount Sinai in Arabia and corresponds to the present (day) Jerusalem, because she is in slavery with her children. But the Jerusalem above is free; and is our mother.

Gal 4:24-26

The Eternal One will greatly bless Abraham, and He will greatly multiply his seed as the stars of the heavens and as the sand which is on the seashore; and his seed will possess the gates of their enemies. Gen 22:17

The previous and the following verse are referring to the promises God made to Abraham regarding his Descendants. These are two Great multitudes consisting of the Nations/Gentiles and the twelve tribes of Israel.

And you have said, "I will surely prosper you and make your descendants as the sand of the sea, too great a multitude to be numbered."

Gen 32:12

Abraham lived in tents and was looking forward to the enduring city made by the hand of God.

When Abraham was called, he obeyed God and went out to a place that he was to receive as an inheritance; and he went out, not knowing where he was going. By faith he was living as an alien in the land of promise. He was living in this foreign land, dwelling in tents with Isaac and Jacob who are fellow heirs of the same promise; Abraham was looking for the city with enduring foundations, whose architect and builder is God. ... The ones having their sight on these things make it clear they are seeking a country of their own. Heb 11:8-10, 14

As the Church, we already realize the Heavenly Jerusalem, yet in the future, will fulfill the desires of the Saints of old: They being made complete through us, and us through them; because as Jesus said, "salvation is from the Jew" (Jn 4:22.)

All the Saints of old were gaining approval through their faith but did not receive what was promised; because God was providing something better for them through the Church, so that without us, they would have not been made complete. Heb 11:39-40

Beings that we are the Body of The Anointed One, we are having direct access to the temple of the Heavenly Jerusalem through His Spirit that is in Us.

...you have come to Mount Zion and to the city of the living God, the heavenly Jerusalem, and to myriads of angels, to the general assembly and church of the firstborn who are enrolled in heaven, and to God, the Judge of all, and to the spirits of the righteous made perfect. [Heb 12:22-23 NASB]

Being in Christ, we are seeing that everything belongs to us through Our Mutual Anointing.

Therefore let no man glory in men: for all things are yours: Whether Paul, or Apollos, or Cephas, or the world, or life, or death, or things present, or things to come; all are yours; And ye are Christ's; and Christ is God's.

[1Co 3:21-23 WEB]

2Co 1:21 He who establishes us with you in Christ and anointed us is God,

We are seeing that the Sons of Abraham are a multitude as the sands of the Sea. Despite any resistance/persecution they receive throughout history; they will be well received by the end.

Yet the number of the people of Israel shall be like the sand of the sea, which can be neither measured nor numbered; and in the place where it was said to them, "You are not my people," it shall be said to them, "Sons of the living God." [Hos 1:10 RSV]

The sons of Israel will always be seen in the perspective of a multitude; whereas the Body of Christ, in the perspective of one, yet having many parts with various functions being distributed by One and the same Spirit. Like the Human body is One with many parts, so are those in Christ.

We have many parts in one body and all the parts do not have the same function; therefore we, who are many, are one body in Christ, and individual parts of one another. Rom 12:4-5

Because even as the body is one and yet has many parts, and all the parts of the body, though they are many, are one body, so also is Christ. Therefore, by one Spirit we were all baptized into one body, whether Jews or Greeks, whether slaves or free; and we were all made to drink of one Spirit. ... But now there are many parts, but one body. 1Co 12:12-13, 20

There is one body and one Spirit, just as you were called in one hope of your calling. [Eph 4:4 NKJV]

Therefore we were buried with Him through baptism into death, that just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also should walk in newness of life. [Rom 6:4 NKJV]

Christ has been raised from the dead and is the first fruits of those who are asleep. ... But each group in his own order: Christ the first fruits; after that, those who are Christ's at His coming. 1Co 15:20, 23

You have put all things in subjection under his feet." For in that He put all in subjection under him, He left nothing [that is] not put under him. But now we do not yet see all things put under him. [Heb 2:8 NKJV]

Christ will continue to reign until He has put all His enemies under His feet. 1Co 15:25

Even while we were dead in our transgressions, God made us alive together with Christ/The Anointed One (by grace we are saved), God raised us up with Him, and seated us with Him in the heavenly places in Christ Jesus. Eph 2:5-6

If you have been raised up with Christ, keep seeking the things from above, where Christ is, seated at the right hand of God. Col 3:1

In the Anointing of Christ the whole building is being fitted together and is growing into the holy temple in the Lord. In Him we are being built together into the dwelling of God in the Spirit. Eph 2:21-22

These Great truths are known to us by Jesus shocking us into the reality that He is really in us; thus, shocked into the realities of God's existence.

[Jhn 6:44, 48, 51, 53-57, 63 NASB]

44 "No one can come to Me unless the Father who sent Me draws him; and I will raise him up on the last day. ... 48 "I am the bread of life. ... 51 "I am the living bread that came down out of heaven; if anyone eats of this bread, he will live forever; and the bread also which I will give for the life of the world is My flesh." ... 53 So Jesus said to them, "Truly, truly, I say to you, unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink His blood, you have no life in yourselves. 54 "He who eats My flesh and drinks

My blood has eternal life, and I will raise him up on the last day. 55 "For My flesh is true food, and My blood is true drink. 56 "He who eats My flesh and drinks My blood abides in Me, and I in him. 57 "As the living Father sent Me, and I live because of the Father, so he who eats Me, he also will live because of Me. ... 63 "It is the Spirit who gives life; the flesh profits nothing; the words that I have spoken to you are spirit and are life."

Since there is one bread, we who are many are one body; because we are all partakers of one bread. 1Co 10:17

Symbolically, Jesus' Flesh is the Word of God/Bread/Body; and His Blood/Wine is God's Spirit. God is Spirit and Truth/Blood and Body/Wine and Bread. The Body of God is His Word while the Blood/Substance of God is Spirit. Man is Flesh and Blood while God is Spirit and Truth.

There is One God/Spirit, and all those who believe have drunk, partaking of the same.

By one Spirit all of us were baptized into one body, whether Jews or Greeks, whether slaves or free, Therefore, we were all made to drink of one Spirit. 1Co 12:13

There is one body and one Spirit, just as also you were called in one hope. Eph 4:4

The one who joins himself to the Lord is one Spirit. 1Co 6:17

I have been crucified with Christ; and it is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me; and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself up for me. [Gal 2:20 NASB]

Few understand that <u>we are</u> literally <u>one</u> creature in the Anointing of the Savior. We are One Spiritual Flesh; A new creation, <u>a congregation/church in one Spirit</u>; and we will continue to expose these great truths.

Don't you know that we will be judging the angels? 1Co 6:3a

The God of peace will soon crush Satan under your feet. The grace of our Lord Jesus be with you. [Rom 16:20 NASB]

YOU HAVE PUT ALL THINGS IN SUBJECTION UNDER HIS FEET." In subjecting all things to Him, He left nothing that is not subjected to Him. But for now, we are not yet seeing everything subjected to Him.

Heb 2:8

WHO HAS KNOWN THE MIND OF THE LORD, THAT HE WOULD INSTRUCT HIM? Yet we have the mind of Christ. 1Co 2:16

Look at how great a love the Father has bestowed on us, that we be called children of God; and, certainly we are. And for this reason, the world does not know us, because it did not know Him. Beloved, we are now children of God, but it has not appeared as yet what we will be. We know that when He appears, we will be like Him, and will see Him just as He is. And everyone having this hope fixed on Him purifies himself, just as He is pure. 1Jo 3:1-3

The Apostle John indicates there was some question as to our disposition in the eternal state; yet God chose him to write down the most astounding truths we could ever know.

'He who overcomes, I will grant to him to sit down with Me on My throne, Just as I overcame and sat down with My Father on His throne. 'He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit is saying to the churches.'" Rev 3:21-22

Rev 1:10, 12-13

The Apostle John was in the Spirit on the Lord's day, and he heard a loud voice behind him sounding like that of a trumpet. 12 When John turned to see the voice that was speaking he saw seven golden lampstands. 13 In the middle of the lampstands John saw one like a son of man, clothed in a robe reaching to His feet, with a golden sash girded across His chest. Rev 1:16, 20 In His right hand He was holding seven stars, and out of His mouth came a sharp two-edged sword; and His face was shining like the sun. 20 Regarding the mystery of the stars we see in the Saviors right hand, and the seven golden lampstands: the seven stars are the angels of the seven churches, and the seven lampstands are the seven churches.

Before moving on, it is good to reveal that the mysteries of the book of Revelations are in part solved by looking to the book of Daniel. The Seven Stars in the right hand of the Lord are symbolic of Pastors being the Principal actor our Lord uses to build up the body of Christ in His word. The Seven Churches of Asia, although they existed historically, represent (symbolically) the Church as a whole from its inauguration on the day of Pentecost to its culmination. Jesus admonished the Seven Congregations of Asia revealing every issue His body will face throughout this age. The Pastors are spoke of as Angels/Messengers/Stars delivering messages from the hand of the Lord.

"Those who are having insight will shine brightly like the brightness of the expanse in the heavens, and those who are leading many to righteousness, are like the stars forever and ever. Dan 12:3

The Apostle John wrote down these things so all of God's Children would know the mysteries of the past, present, and future; that we would know the friends and foes of God. The Greater insight will be revealed by **following the** ((Sevens)) to the throne. In this way we know who we truly are.

The Seven Lampstands are The Seven Churches

[Rev 2:1 NASB] 1 "To the angel of the church in Ephesus write: The One who holds the seven stars in His right hand, the One who walks among the seven golden lampstands, says this: [Rev 2:10-11 NASB] 10 'Do not fear what you are about to suffer. Behold, the devil is about to cast some of you into prison, so that you will be tested, and you will have tribulation for ten days. Be faithful until death, and I will give

you (the crown of life). 11 'He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the churches. He who overcomes will not be hurt by the second death.' [Rev 2:17 NASB] 17 'He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the churches. To him who overcomes, to him I will give some of the hidden manna, and I will give him a white stone, and a new name written on the stone which no one knows but he who receives it.'

[Rev 2:26-28 NASB] 26 'He who overcomes, and he who keeps My deeds until the end, TO HIM I WILL GIVE AUTHORITY OVER THE NATIONS; 27 AND HE SHALL RULE THEM WITH A ROD OF IRON, AS THE VESSELS OF THE POTTER ARE BROKEN TO PIECES, as I also have received authority from My Father; 28 and I will give him the morning star.

[Rev 3:5, 12, 21-22 NASB] 5 'He who overcomes will thus be clothed in white garments; and I will not erase his name from the book of life, and I will confess his name before My Father and before His angels. ... 12 'He who overcomes, I will make him a pillar in the temple of My God, and he will not go out from it anymore; and ((I will write on him the name of My God)), and ((the name of the city of My God, the new Jerusalem)), which comes down out of heaven from My God, ((and My new name)). ... 21 'He who overcomes, I will grant to him to sit down with Me on My throne, as I also overcame and sat down with My Father on His throne. 22 'He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the churches.'"

[Rev 4:1-2, 5 NASB] these things I looked, and behold, a door standing open in heaven, and the first voice which I had heard, like the sound of a trumpet speaking with me, said, "Come up here, and I will show you what must take place after these things." 2 Immediately I was in the Spirit; and behold, a throne was standing in heaven, and One sitting on the throne. ... 5 Out from the throne come flashes of lightning and sounds and peals of thunder. And there were (((seven lamps of fire burning before the throne))), which are the seven Spirits of God.

Climactic events are preceded by lightning and thunder... Seven Lamps of fire suddenly appear and are burning before the throne which are the seven Spirits of God. We will talk about the living creatures.

Rev 4:6-8 NASB and before the throne there was something like a sea of glass, like crystal; and in the center and around the throne, four living creatures full of eyes in front and behind. 7 The first creature was like a lion, and the second creature like a calf, and the third creature had a face like that of a man, and the fourth creature was like a flying eagle. 8 And the four living creatures, each one of them having six wings, are full of eyes around and within; and day and night they do not cease to say, "HOLY, HOLY, HOLY is THE LORD GOD, THE ALMIGHTY, WHO WAS AND WHO IS AND WHO IS TO COME." Rev 4:6-8 NASB

These are all of God's creatures gathered before the throne waiting for their King to Show up. Notice that it says they are "Living Creatures." And also notice they are full of eyes inside and out; indicative of a multitude/a great congregation within each creature.

There is the anxious longing of the creation that is eagerly waiting for the revealing of the sons of God. Rom 8:19

The lion is the king of the wild Animals, The Bullock/Calf is the king of the domestic animals, The Face like a Man are the Angels having responsibilities within the affairs of the Sons of God, and the Eagle being the King of everything in God's creation that flies. These Creatures of earth will be in Spirit form, in the throne room, eagerly waiting to give glory to the Sons of God.

Rom 8:14, 19-21 All of us who are being led by the Spirit of God, are the sons of God. ... 19 And there is the anxious longing of all creation eagerly waiting for the revealing of the sons of God. 20 Because the creation itself was subjected to futility, not willingly, but because of Him who subjected it, with the confident expectation 21 that the creation itself will be set free from slavery to what is perishing into the freedom of the glory of the children of God. Rom 8:14, 19-21

And every created thing which is in heaven and on the earth and under the earth and on the sea, and all things in them, I heard saying, "To Him who sits on the throne, and to the Lamb, be blessing and honor and glory and dominion forever and ever." And the four living creatures kept saying, "Amen." And the elders fell down and worshiped.

[Rev 5:13-14 NASB]

John heard the sound of a trumpet, this being indicative of the Rapture of the Church; Thus, those of us remaining on earth resurrecting and rendezvousing with the Savior in the clouds above the earth along with those having fallen asleep before; with all of us hidden in the Eternal Savior, appearing before the throne symbolically as Seven Lamps, thus, the light of the world.

Jesus said, "As long as I am in the world, I am the light of the world." Jhn 9:5

Jesus said, "You are the light of the world. A city set on a hill cannot be hidden." He was saying this to the crowds that were believing in Him on the hill. Mat 5:14

The life in man is the lamp of the LORD, Searching all the innermost parts of his being. Pro 20:27

Now we are all gathered together before the throne ready to be revealed in the Glory of the Lamb.

Rev 5:1-3, 6

1 The Apostle John was looking and saw a book in the right hand of Him who is sitting on the throne, and it was written inside and on the back, and was sealed with seven seals. 2 Then John saw a strong angel calling out with a loud voice, "Who is worthy to open the book and to break the seals?" 3 Yet no one in heaven, on the earth, or under the earth was able to open up the book to look into it. ... 6 Immediately after this John saw in the midst of the throne (with the four living creatures) and the elders a Lamb standing, as if it had been slain, having seven horns and seven eyes, (((((which are the seven Spirits of God, sent out into all the earth.)))))

Here we have it: The body of Christ complete and sitting on the throne just as Jesus promised to all those who "overcome"

"To him who overcomes I will grant to sit **with Me on My throne**, as I also overcame and sat down with My Father on His throne." Rev 3:21 NKJV

Rev 5:7-10

Then we come and take the book from the right hand of Him who is sitting on the throne. 8 When we have taken the book, then the four living creatures and the twenty-four elders will fall down before the Lamb/Us, each one holding a harp and golden bowls full of incense, which are all the unanswered prayers of the saints throughout history. 9 Then they will sing a new song, saying, "Worthy are You to take the book and to break its seals; because You were slain, and purchased for God with Your blood men from every tribe and tongue and people and nation. 10 "You have made them to be a kingdom and priests to our God; and they will reign upon the earth." Rev 5:7-10

We Know that <u>our old self was crucified with Him</u>, so that our body of sin would be done away with, in order that we would no longer be in slavery to sin. Rom 6:6

Remember: we saw the Lamb standing, as if it had been slain, having seven horns and seven eyes, (((((which are the seven Spirits of God, sent out into all the earth.)))))

The Spirit Himself is testifying to our Spirit that we are children of God. Therefore, since we are children we are heirs of God and fellow heirs with Christ, since we suffered with Him, in order that we be glorified together in Him. Rom 8:16-17

We have died and our life is hidden within Christ in God. Therefore, when Christ is revealed, who is our life, then we will be revealed with Him in glory.

Col 3:3-4

Now if anyone has died with Christ, we also believe we will live in Him. Rom 6:8

With the mysteries of our Throne being revealed, thus being joint-heirs with Christ, how could we expect greater things than these, except that we receive our bride, The New Jerusalem? This subject is the very center of the greatest false doctrine ever created by Satan through the Great Harlot. Remember, the Great Harlot Says there is no Rapture, no Spirits of living creatures in heaven, no Thousand-year kingdom for Israel, and really no New Jerusalem as so vividly described in the scriptures, and no New heaven and earth. The Harlot is asserting there is no Glory beyond what She has created with her own energy in nearly two millennia. The center of this deception is Satan's aspiration to exterminate all Jews from the face of the earth; even trying to erase any thoughts in us of God's glorious future for them. This deception goes hand in hand with the greatest forgery that will ever be known to mankind in that it sought to erase over one thousand years of Biblical History, and even the eternal state.

We have already seen that we have inherited the throne of God, also breaking the Seven Seals giving previews regarding the trumpets. Three and a half days after the middle of the week, the temple of heaven is closed until the bowls of wrath are complete. We have seen that the 144,000 Jewish martyrs are in permanent attendance with the Lamb; having been murdered because of the word of God. In the

final 1256 ½ days there are very few casualties until We return sweeping the earth clean of God's enemies; this campaign being Called the Great Supper of God.

The Great Harlot would have us believe Revelations Chapter nineteen verses seven through nine is a reception related to marriage; but nothing could be farther from the truth; because these three verses are a forgery and need to be removed from the chapter. The actual Marriage of the Lamb takes place more than one thousand years after Our return to earth, establishing Our one-thousand-year reign.

And I saw the holy city, **new Jerusalem**, coming down out of heaven from God, made ready as **a bride** adorned for her husband. [Rev 21:2 NASB]

At this point we will display the truths regarding these things, also pointing out the spin the Harlot puts on **Ephesians 5:21-32** in order to seal up Her deceptions on humanity. The main deception to the Harlot's interpretation of the following is refusal to acknowledge basic context. The major precedence in context is a Husband and wife ((they are married)); just as Christ (the Head) is married to the (body) the Church. By the time we acknowledge verse twenty-eight through thirty, there's the realization **The Church is Christ's own Flesh/Spirit/Body**. If one does not acknowledge this, they are no longer Acknowledged; because the body of Christ isn't flesh but Spirit, because flesh and blood cannot inherit the kingdom of heaven.

Be subject to each other in the fear of The Anointed One/Christ. Wives, be subject to your very own husbands, as though the Lord. Because the husband is the head of the wife, just as The Anointed One/Christ is the head of the Church, He Himself being the Savior of the Body. Just as the Church is subject to Christ/The Anointed One, so also the wives ought to be to their husbands in everything. Husbands, love your wives, just as The Anointed One also loved the Church and gave Himself up for Her, so that He might sanctify Her, having cleansed Her by the washing of water with the word, that He present to Himself the Church in all her glory, having no spot or wrinkle or any such thing; but that She would be holy and blameless. So husbands should also love their very own wives as their own bodies. He who loves his own wife loves himself; Because no one ever hated his own flesh, but nourishes and cherishes it; just as Christ does the church, because we are parts of His body. BECAUSE OF THIS A MAN WILL LEAVE HIS FATHER AND MOTHER AND JOIN TO HIS WIFE, AND THE TWO BECOME ONE FLESH. This mystery is great; but I am speaking with reference to Christ and the church

Eph 5:21-32

The Following two verses are rendered true to the Greek, with the lying words of the scribes ("with him") removed from the end of each verse...

Don't you know that the one who joins himself to a prostitute is <u>one body</u>? Because He says, "THE TWO BECOME ONE FLESH." But the one who joins himself to the Lord is <u>one Spirit</u>. 1Co 6:16-17

"How can you say, 'We are wise, And the law of the LORD is with us'? But behold, the lying pen of the scribes Has made it into a lie. [Jer 8:8 NASB]

The Great Harlot is the Woman with Strong Spells, her early fathers holding the lying pen; teaching tradition but never encouraging anyone to thoroughly examine the scriptures; because it would wash us of her deceptions, and her kingdom would come tumbling down. Again, at the close of the Seventh bowl of wrath, We sweep the earth clean of those having the mark of the beast and worshiped his image, along with any other remnants of unbelievers. Revelations Chapter Twenty shows us Satan being bound for a thousand years, and the thrones of the twelve Apostles of the Lamb set up to judge the twelve tribes of Israel. The rewards of the righteous who resisted the beast mark, being beheaded because of their testimony of Jesus, the souls of these are resurrected to reign with the Lamb/Us for a thousand years. At the end of the thousand years, Satan is released and Gathers the Armies of the North/The Gog Revolution, and will surround the camp of the Saints and the City; yet Fire comes down from heaven devouring and putting an end to Our Enemies. Chapter Twenty closes out with all the unrighteous dead being raised, judged, and thrown into the lake of fire forever.

With all of Our enemies put away forever, Chapter Twenty-one takes us to God creating the new heavens and earth especially for the new Jerusalem coming down out of Heaven. We/The Lamb is the Temple and the light shining forth in The New Jerusalem/New City of Peace. We will then be married/united in Jerusalem/Israel/Her; and the nations will follow Our light.

The Church is already One Body/Spirit united in Christ, "the head of the Body." In the future, thus the eternal state, Israel and The Lamb are united/married forever. In other words, Christ and the Church are one Spiritual Flesh already; whereas The Bride, and future Wife of the Lamb, is the New Jerusalem formed by the hands of God as the eternal habitation for the Spirits of the righteous of Israel and the nations, these as numerous as the sands of the sea shore.

... "Come, I will show you **the bride, the wife of the Lamb**." And he carried me away in the Spirit to a mountain great and high, and showed me **the Holy City, Jerusalem**, coming down out of heaven from God. [Rev 21:9*b*-10 NIV]

Jesus answered, "If anyone loves me, he will keep my word. My Father will love him, and we will come to him and make our home with him. [Jhn 14:23 CSB]

You are not in the flesh but in the Spirit, if in fact the Spirit of God dwells in you. If anyone does not have the Spirit of Christ, he does not belong to Him. Rom 8:9

The Lord is the Spirit, and wherever the Spirit of the Lord is, there is liberty. All those, with unveiled face, are beholding the Lord as in a mirror, and are being transformed into the same image from glory to glory, just as from the Lord, the Spirit.
