The Living Creatures

With the Church advanced to the Throne at the Rapture there is much glory for The Lamb and His Creatures. We can see the mystery of the Rapture through seven lamps said to be the Church by Jesus. The Word Church means Congregation.

Jesus said, "The mystery of the seven stars which you saw in My right hand, and the seven golden lampstands: the seven stars are the messengers of the seven churches, and the seven lampstands are the seven churches. Rev 1:20

The Apostle John saw Jesus in the middle of the seven lamp stands. Jesus indicated He walks among the churches; indicative of a personal relationship/fellowship with Him. Rev 1:12-13; 2:1

After we believe in Jesus/Eternal Savior, we will overcome through God's power.

Whatever is born of God <u>overcomes</u> the world; the victory that overcomes the world is our faith. Who is the one who <u>overcomes</u> the world? it's he who believes that the Eternal Savior/Jesus is the Son of God 1Jo 5:4-5

Jesus talks about all the things We receive when We overcome.

Through faith in the Eternal Savior we overcome. Jesus says that he who overcomes, He will Grant that they eat of the tree of life in the paradise of God. Adam and Eve were banished from the tree of life and the Garden of Eden. Gen 3:22-24; Rev 2:7

Those who overcome will not be hurt by the second death. The Second death is the lake of fire, the final destination reserved for those refusing the redemption solution of the Eternal Savior. Rev 2:11; Rev 20:14

Jesus says that he who overcomes will receive some hidden manna/deep truth, and a white stone/commendation with a new name only known to the individual to whom it is given and the Lord. Rev 2:17

"THE THINGS THAT THE EYE HAS NOT SEEN NOR HAS THE EAR HEARD, AND NEITHER HAVE THEY ENTERED INTO

THE HEART OF MAN, ARE ALL THE THINGS THAT GOD HAS PREPARED FOR THOSE WHO LOVE HIM." 1Co 2:9

Again, Jesus says that he who overcomes will be given authority to rule the nations with a Rod of Iron, Just as He also received from His Father. The Savior will also give Us The Morning Star, which is Himself. Rev 2:26-28

"I, Jesus, have sent My messenger to testify these things to the churches. I am the root and the descendant of David, the bright morning star." Rev 22:16

'He who overcomes will thus be clothed in white garments; and I will not erase his name from the book of life, and I will confess his name before My Father and before His angels. [Rev 3:5 NASB]

The following reference is important to remember to solve the mystery...

In Revelation 21:22-23 we read John was not seeing a temple in The New Jerusalem, because <u>the Lord God Almighty and the Lamb are its temple</u>. The city has no need of the sun or moon to shine on it, because <u>the glory of God illuminates it with the (((lamp being the Lamb)))</u>.

'He who overcomes, I will make him a pillar in the temple of My God, and he will not go out from it anymore; and I will write on him the name of My God, and the name of the city of My God, the new Jerusalem, which comes down out of heaven from My God, and My new name. [Rev 3:12 NASB]

Revelation 3:21. This final one is Jesus saying that he who overcomes will be granted to sit down with Him on His throne, just like Jesus overcame and sat down with His Father on His throne.

He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the churches. Rev 3:22

It's important to note there is only one throne in relation to God; so, watch what's going to happen next, because this is the Apostle John caught up in God's simulator of the Rapture of the Church.

After these things John was looking and saw a door standing open in heaven, and the first voice John heard, that was sounding <u>like that of a trumpet</u> speaking with him, said, "<u>Come up here, and I will show you what must take place after these things." Rev 4:1</u>

in a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trumpet; for the trumpet will sound, and the dead will be raised imperishable, and we will be changed. [1Co 15:52 NASB]

Immediately John was in the Spirit; and he saw that a throne was standing in heaven, with someone sitting on the throne that looked like jasper stone and a sardius; with a rainbow around the throne, having the appearance of an emerald (This is God). Around the throne there were twenty-four thrones with twenty-four elders sitting in white garments with golden crowns on their heads (these are the Apostles of the Lamb who will be Judges presiding over the twelve tribes of Israel during the millennium, along with the twelve heads of each tribe.) Rev 4:2-4

Now, do you remember that Jesus said that the Seven Lamps are the Seven Churches?... Now we have the Seven Lamps burning in front of the Throne in the following verse; but this time adding they are the Seven Spirits of God.

Then from the throne came flashes of lightning and peals of thunder; then suddenly there were seven lamps of fire burning before the throne, which are the seven Spirits of God. Rev 4:5

These Lamps burning before the throne are the entire Church/Congregation ready to be seated on the Throne. Now, do you remember what Jesus said? Jesus said that He who overcomes, will be granted to sit down with Him on His throne, just like He overcame and sat down with His Father on His throne. "He who is having an ear, let him hear what the Spirit is saying to the churches." Rev 3:21-22

The Apostle John was looking and saw in the middle of the throne and of the four living creatures, and in the middle of the elders, a <u>Lamb standing as if slain</u>, <u>having seven horns and seven eyes</u>, <u>which are the seven Spirits of God</u>, <u>sent out into all the earth</u>. Rev 5:6

There We are, the slain Lamb sitting on Our Throne!!! <u>The Seven</u>

<u>Eyes</u> are indicative there being a Great Multitude in One
Body/Church/Congregation, just as we see all of Creation (The Living
Creatures <u>full of Eyes</u>) "around" the Throne.

Ezekiel and the Apostle Paul are witnesses of the fact that God intends to save all the Spirits of the Animal Kingdom.

The Apostle Paul considered the sufferings of this time not worthy to be compared with the glories to be revealed to us in the future. There is the anxious longing of creation eagerly waiting for the revealing of the sons of God. Rom 8:18-19

We have died, and Our life is hidden within Christ in God. When Christ, who is our life, is revealed, then We also will be revealed with Him in glory. Col 3:3-4

All creation was subjected to futility, not willingly, but because of Him who subjected it, that the creation itself will also be set free from its slavery to what is perishing into the freedom of the glory of the children of God. We know that all of creation groans and suffers the pains of childbirth together until now. And not only this; we ourselves, having the first fruits of the Spirit, are groaning within ourselves, eagerly waiting for our adoption as sons, the redemption of our body. Rom 8:20-23

On the throne we are revealed in glory, in that the Living Creatures are giving their praise to the Lamb. The Lamb is Our new name being in union with Our Lord and is found thirty-one times starting from Revelations 5:6 to 22:3. Thus, we're holding this name from the time of the Congregation's Rapture and thereafter into eternity.

The following verse speaks of the eternal state and is rendered as it appears in the Hebrew, (((without))) the deceptive words that are typically added to this verse. The Name Jehovah, erroneously translated LORD, literally means Eternal One and should always be translated correctly. One should note that word "Adonay" is the actual Hebrew word meaning Lord.

The Eternal One will be king over all the earth; and in that day the Eternal One will be one, and His name one. Zec 14:9

The redemption of all Creation is conclusive evidence of God's Love for all that He Created; drawing all of His Creatures to Himself in the Eternal State.

Before the throne is the sea of glass like crystal and will be the eternal habitation for the Spirits of aquatic life. Around the throne, are the four living creatures that are full of eyes in front and behind; within each creature being a Congregation/Great Multitude. The first creature is like a lion and therefore the King of all creatures that are wild. Rev 4:6-7*a*

"The wolf and the lamb will graze together, and the lion will eat straw like the ox; and dust will be the serpent's food. They will do no evil or harm in all My holy mountain," says the LORD. [Isa 65:25 NASB]

The second creature looks like a calf/bullock and is the most prized work Animal of Antient times; this Living Creature is the King of all domesticated Animals. Rev 4:7*b*

Where no oxen are, the manger is clean, But much revenue comes by the strength of the ox. [Pro 14:4 NASB]

Third are those with a face like that of a man, these being the earthly cast of Angels bound to affairs related to protecting mankind. The fourth living creature is the flying eagle, thus King of everything that takes flight. ... We are having this view into the future when all of God's creatures can talk giving glory, honor, and thanksgiving to Him who sits on the throne. Rev 4.7c-9

Every created thing which is in heaven, on the earth, under the earth, and on the sea, with all things in them, John heard saying, "To Him who sits on the throne, and to the Lamb, let there be blessing, honor, glory, and dominion forever and ever." Then the four living creatures kept saying, "Amen." And the elders fell down and worshiped. Rev 5:13-14
