Safety Rules - Firearms

The three basic rules of firearm safety as formulated by the NRA are to be observed at all times.

- 1. Always keep your firearm pointed in a safe direction. A safe direction is defined as a direction which would not result in an injury in the event of an accidental discharge.
- 2. Always keep your finger off of the trigger until you are ready to shoot.
- 3. Always keep your gun unloaded and the action open until ready to shoot.

Range hours are 8 a.m. to Sunset, unless special events are scheduled outside these time frames. Raise main gate red flag when entering to shoot.

Children 16 and under must be supervised by an adult 21 years or older

Range flag at the main gate must be raised anytime you are on the property shooting. Range Flags on all ranges must be raised on the range you are shooting at. South Range Rifles must be fired from the Bench only!!!

Except for special targets provided by the club or as novelties at club matches, the only targets, which are permissible on the firearms ranges are paper targets or cardboard style targets mounted on the provided wood target frames. Blue rock target are acceptable as long as they are placed on the berm not above eye level. Because of the high probability of ricochets, no target is ever to be shot when it is resting on the ground. Please remove all paper targets from targets boards when done firing and place in provided trash cans. Glass is never to be used as a target.

Never move ahead of the firing line when the line is "hot" or shoot from behind the firing line when other shooters are forward of your position. Never shoot if any person is on the range ahead of the firing line. The center range is designated as a pistol and rimfire range, no high power rifle or shotguns are allowed on this range unless prior approval of the Executive Committee. The North range is designated as a handgun and rifle range. Rifles have priority on this range! All steel targets shot by a rifle are to be shot only from the 100 yard line and no ammunition over 3000 FPS or steel core projectiles are allowed on the range. Provided there is no one wanting to use it for rifle. If a rifle shooter should show up while you are shooting, finish you stage of fire and relinquish the range to the rifle shooter. The trap range is utilized during the year by scheduled dates and times, please check the club calendar on our web page. When the trap range is in use the center range and rifle range are closed. The North range may be utilized during this time. The range will be closed to personal use during any scheduled event on the club calendar or event approved by the Executive committee.

Please check the clubs calendar at **flaa.us** for range closer, and work days, events and matches. All ranges will be closed for qualification of Larned Police Dept. and Pawnee County Sherriff Dept.

Life Members and annual members may bring family members and guest for the day. (not more than 5 guest) If family members are above 18 or not living at home, they must be members.

Do not discard Dud shell in the trash cans, please dispose of them properly.

Alcohol and firearms do not mix. There is to be no consumption of alcohol at any time before or during any event when firearms are present.

Eye and ear protection are required for all firearm activity.

When a range master is present, obey all range commands immediately.

A range orientation is required before you membership is active. Please contact Scott Peterson for this orientation. 620 639 2751

Any violation of these rules or the safe handling of firearms depending on the severity may result in a warning or immediate withdrawal of membership privileges an immediate removal from the range with no refund of fees paid.
