Communication and Language - What I can do now:

I talk in simply sentences and can string two or three words together. I can repeat familiar phrases such as 'all gone' and 'bye-bye'. I understand simple instructions and listen with intent, but I do sometimes get distracted. I can make my feelings known and get my needs met by using gestures if I am frustrated. I am learning new words rapidly and particularly enjoy repeating our 'words of the day' and I will use some Makaton signs I have learned at nursery. My mummy tells my key person that I also use these at home.

Personal, Social and Emotional - What I can do now:

I will seek comfort from people who are familiar to me, I can say when I am feeling sad and happy. I have words but I will also use gestures to make my needs know if needed, e.g., pointing to my cup or bag for my comforter. I am confident to explore the room on my own, knowing that my key person is nearby, and I am starting to engage in play with others. I show desire to be independent and I want to try to do things on my own.

Physical Development - What I can do now:

I am confident mover; I am developing these skills further by climbing and riding on bikes and trikes at nursery. I am learning to feed myself and I am keen to do it myself. I can also wash my hands and wipe my own face after eating. I like to explore spaces such as fitting myself inside boxes and crawling through tunnels. I can roll and kick balls, and I like to shout 'goal' when I get it in to a goal, I often set these up myself using items I find in the garden.

All about my other areas of learning: Literacy, Maths, Understanding the World, Expressive Art and Design

I enjoy looking at stories and I have my favourites including 'The gruffalo', I like to point at his features and name them, including 'wart' 'prickles'. I like to explore different media and material to create masterpieces that I like to take home, I particularly like glue and collage and using my hands to spread paint onto paper. I like to explore tinkering items, and I will keep trying to achieve the end product e.g. finding keys to unlock padlocks at the tinkering table. I show interest in the world around me, and I like to help the adults care for the environment by water the plants, digging up the potatoes in the vegetable patch and putting bird seed into the feeders. I notice when the seed tube is empty and will tell adults 'all gone'.
