Guidelines for Displaying Artwork in the Perquimans Arts League (PAL) Gallery

- 1. Artist must be a member of PAL prior to the jury process.
- 2. Juried artist must make an appointment to drop off the work to be exhibited.
- 3. Artist's work must have been juried in the category in which the work falls.
- 4. Only members of the Jury Committee can accept work.
- 5. Not all work will be accepted, depending on available space, size of the piece and compatibility.
- 6. The three-month display limit will be enforced.
- 7. The number of pieces each artist can display will be included in the contract and will be determined by the limitations of the gallery at that time.
- 8. Each piece for exhibition must be no older than 2 years and not displayed previously in the gallery. Special retrospective exhibits are excluded.
- 9. Display labels, including title, medium, artist and date are provided by gallery.
- 10. Artists must be juried into the Art on the Perquimans Show.
- 11. To limit false expectations, recruited artists must be made aware of the jury process.
