(with the option of presenting at one of the NJAATSP workshops in 2025) This should include at least a minimum of 2 brief paragraphs and 2-4 photos recapping the project status.

-What is the Project about? (theme, timeline, resources/products needed, budget, etc.) -What is the need/goal being met by this project?

-How will this help you be a more effective educator who can best serve your learners within the world language department?

-What is your school context? (demographics, resources)

-Creativity, originality, and connection to teaching World Languages will all be considered.

Your application responses should provide enough information for the Grant Review Board to understand the purpose of your application and who will benefit from the award. (400 words max.)
