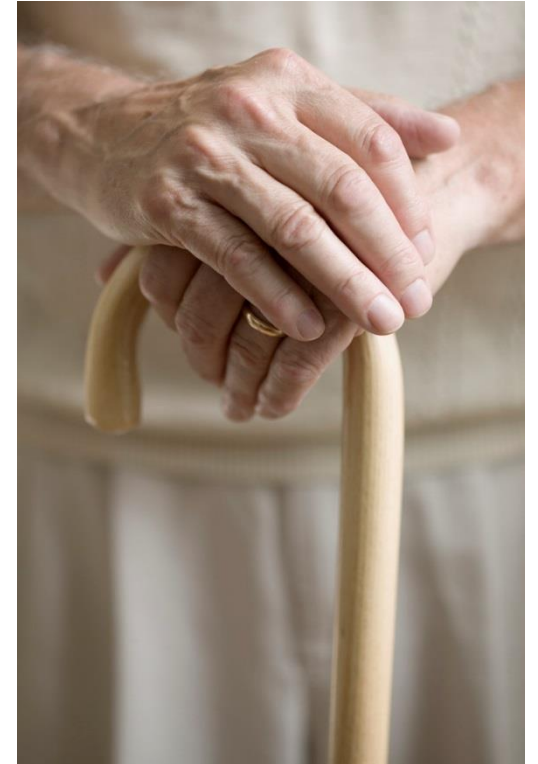

TIER II - MODIFICATIONS

Income Eligibility:

- 1 Person Household = \$60,000
- 2 Person Household = \$68,550

Items Available:

- Hand Held Showers Heads
- Light Toggle Switches (for bedrooms, bathrooms, and kitchen)
- Lever Door Handles
- Smoke/Carbon Detectors
- Toilet seat Modifiers
- Tub/Shower Benches
- Tub Safety Mats
- Throw Rug Tape
- Motion Activated Night Lights
- Grab Bars (excluding tub/shower install)

Cost

Program is FREE to income eligible households.
