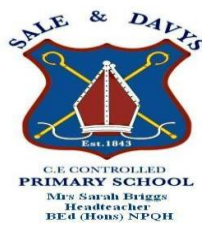

### Parent helpers

### School Uniform

Dresses should be worn with white socks. Grey shorts/grey skirts should be worn with grey socks. Please see our website for more information on school uniform. ### Attendance

Attendance is extremely important and it is closely linked to attainment and progress. Research shows that those children with low attendance achieve lower SATs scores. We understand that all children get ill from time to time but if they have a cold or a cough or mild symptoms please send them into school. We will always contact you if we think your child needs to go home.

### Forest School Activities

Forest School sessions will recommence on Friday 7<sup>th</sup> June for Dart Class.

### Swimming Trent Class

Swimming will commence on 22<sup>nd</sup> April.

### Equipment

If you wish to purchase equipment for your child ready for the Summer term, the following items will be needed: blue frixion pen, whiteboard pens, pencil, ruler, rubber, pencil sharpener.

### Safeguarding

Online Safety: A reminder to parents. Please ensure that your child is supervised when they are online, especially when they are communicating with friends that they know.

Medicine: If your child needs medicine during the school day, please provide this with their name clearly labelled on the bottle. You will need to complete a medicine form for ALL medicines including non-prescription. Medicines will be administered at midday. We will only administer antibiotics if four doses are required each day. If your child is well, we do not administer medicine as a precaution. Any ongoing medical issues that require adjustments to our policy must be evidenced with a doctor's note.

I hope you all have a lovely Easter with your family and friends. I look forward to seeing you all back on 15<sup>th</sup> April 2024. Thank you for your continued support.

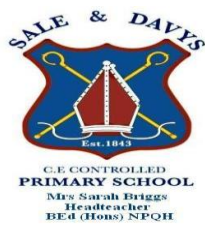
