The <u>human</u> body is a complex <u>machine</u>. It is made up of <u>cells</u>, organs and <u>tissues</u>. Around 60% of the body is <u>water</u>. A baby is born with 270 <u>bones</u>, and this decreases to 206 by adulthood. The <u>brain</u> is the <u>control</u> center and takes in information from the five <u>senses</u> (sight, hearing, smell, taste and touch). The <u>heart</u> pumps <u>blood</u> around the body, keeping it <u>alive</u>.
