



13th Annual Young Artist Scholarship Competition
(2020-2021)

The Woodbridge Flute Choir is pleased to announce its 2020-2021 Young Artist Competition, open to flutists ages 14-18 as of **January 15, 2021**.

Required repertoire: one movement of a flute concerto arranged for flute solo or piccolo solo and flute choir. The piece must be selected from the repertoire list that appears on the competition website unless the flute choir arrangement has been approved in writing by Debbie Gilbert, artistic director, before the entry deadline (**April 15, 2021**). Please contact Debbie Gilbert at jdgilbert99@gmail.com for prior approval of a piece not on the suggested repertoire list. The Grand Prize Winner will receive a \$500 scholarship prize and, circumstances permitting, may perform as a guest artist with the Woodbridge Flute Choir sometime during the Spring or Summer of 2021.

Entries must be received no later than **11:59 pm on April 15, 2021**.

To enter, complete the online application and submit the \$30.00 non-refundable audition fee via PayPal. When payment has been received, applicant will be directed to <https://www.dropbox.com/request/51MJ7qzSCuUCwd9Bu8Oh> to upload a high-quality mp3 formatted recording consisting of the required repertoire played by the flutist. Piano accompaniment is encouraged, but not required at this time due to the pandemic.

Please identify the recording with the name of the flutist, school, and title of piece. **DO NOT upload video recordings.**

Audition process:

1. The mp3 recordings will be evaluated and the Finalists chosen and notified by **May 2, 2021**.
2. Finalists will prepare and upload a video recording of their piece to YouTube that will be viewed and adjudicated by a panel of three judges. This shall be an unlisted YouTube recording. One winner will be chosen.
3. The winner will receive a \$500 scholarship and may be the featured soloist at the Woodbridge Flute Choir's Spring Concert, circumstances permitting.
