Meeting Minutes

November 8, 2022

- Meeting called to order by Angie Korger at 7:04 pm.

• Secretary Report (Nadine Skinner)

Angelica made a motion to approve the October 2022 meeting minutes. Vidhya seconded the motion. All approved, and the motion passed.

• President Report (Angie Korger)

- ➤ Teacher Gifting: Info was resent out to members after Ms. Ward mentioned it in the newsletter. We extended the deadline. Only 5 gifting opportunities came in. We have 1 more opening for our gifting committee. Email Angie if you want to be on the committee.
- ➤ Signs: A-frame signs cost \$175 each plus custom inserts cost \$55. We need signs around the building explaining entrances to use for certain events. It would be good to have 3-4 of these signs. These would come out of the projects budget.
- ➤ Blue Benches: Contacted 2 vendors, including U-Line. Benches like the ones we have cost \$1700, plus at least \$400 shipping. Cheaper versions like the ones in the courtyard are possible to get. Benches have a 12-week lead time. Angie will talk to Ms. Ward and see if there is another solution.

Vice President Report (Angelica Morales)

• Treasurer Report (Rachel Zetino and Vidhya Venkatesan)

- Please turn in expenses.
- Vidhya is working on the \$56 of unclaimed money.
- Current balance as of October 31st is \$72,875.87.

Safety Report (Kali Shiller)

- ➤ She has been in touch with Ms. McGee and Student Council to set a date for trash pickup on Knights Court.
- ➤ We need more parking lot signs. Reflective signs are \$184, and non-reflective signs are \$135. Smaller yard-type signs are \$13 each (quantity of 20) plus \$2 per stake. Kali needs to walk around the parking lot and see where poles are that we can put signs on. Roxanne had a sign suggestion of "Phones Down, Heads Up."
- Kali needs to get with Missouri City about a sign right before the crosswalk.
- ➤ Knights Court lights out/poles bending. Some lights have come back on. Trees need to be trimmed near 2 lights on school property. Will contact Ms. Lourdes.
- Thompson Ferry detour is up and running as of yesterday. But map distributed is not correct. Need another detour sign and an updated map. We may have to come up with a map on our own and give to Ms. Ward.
- We need a new crosswalk at Paradise River and Knights Court. Kali will talk to Missouri City.

• VIPS Report (Nakia Allen and Michelle Tolbert)

- > VIPS meeting was held virtually on October 20th. 2 main topics.
 - o Fort Bend Education Foundation: Grants to schools and teachers are available. Applications are now open until January 26th. Teacher grants from \$500 to \$1500 are provided in the fall semester. School site grants are available too (\$2K maximum per elementary campus and \$5K maximum per secondary campus). There is a maximum of 3 grants per campus. Funding is provided in the fall semester. There are also founders grants with applications due November 30th. These are for up to \$20K for unique, transformative, sustainable programs for school site or departments that enhance education experiences for FBISD students. Information is on the website. You can support the foundation through the 2022 Sugar Shindig and the 2023 Gala (March 4, 2023 at the Sugar Land Marriott).
 - Safety: Discussion of the importance of the VATRE in the upcoming election to provide security for elementary schools; without the VATRE there is no ability to staff elementary schools with on-site security officers. Currently there are 2 officers at each HS campus and 1 officer at each MS campus. No officers at ES campuses. Other safety measures already in place include: controlled access to all entry doors for FB schools (badge entry for staff and intercom/buzz entry for visitors), partnership with FB Sheriff's office, Mo City police, and law enforcement to provide random door checks and additional security presence on FB campuses especially at ES, rhino locks installed on all doors in all FB

classrooms, phones installed in parking lots for school events (phones linked directly to 911), extensive camera/surveillance system (updates will be needed in next several years)
