SUBJECT: Lassen County Now in the Yellow Tier

Effective today, Lassen County is in the "minimal" spread or least restrictive yellow tier of the California Blueprint for a Safer Economy. Lassen County is one of only three counties in this category, joining both Alpine and Sierra counties.

The yellow tier indicates that there is minimal COVID-19 spread in our County and allows for nearly all businesses to reopen indoor operations.

Some of the changes in the Yellow Tier are as follows:

Bars (where no meals provided) - Can open indoors with modifications – Max 25% capacity or 100 people, whichever is fewer.

Churches - Can open indoors with modifications – Max 50% capacity – Capacity limits on places of worship are not mandatory but are strongly recommended.

Gyms and fitness center - Can open indoors with modifications - Max 50% capacity

Hair salons and barbershops - Can open indoors with modifications

Movie theaters - Can open indoors with modifications – Max 50% capacity

Restaurants (dine-in) - Can open indoors with modifications - Max 50% capacity

The Blueprint for a Safer Economy Tier system will end on June 15, 2021, if we are able to contain the spread of the COVID-19 virus.
