To date, the Lassen County COVID-19 (novel coronavirus) total tests are as follows:

0 – Known cases 47 - Negative 6 - Pending 53 – Total Tests

The Lassen County COVID-19 call center was established on March 20, 2020. They average 10 to 15 calls a day. The purpose of the call center is to provide information to the public and refer the caller to their medical provider if they need to be assessed further.

As the COVID-19 (novel coronavirus) cases in the United States reach 330,891, California is preparing for an increase in the number of people who urgently need health care in our communities. The state is opening additional health care sites to treat people affected by COVID-19 and to relieve the pressure on our health care system.
