Players are encouraged to develop a deep sense of respect for all (opponents and officials) while endeavoring to enjoy the sport and improve their playing ability. Each player is expected to use proper skill and technique when engaging in any type of body contact.

Play for fun. Respect the fact that losing is a part of playing the game and you should be just as graceful in your losses as you are in wins.

Understand winning takes hard work, focus and sacrifice.

Work hard to improve your skills.

Be a team player – get along with your teammates.

Learn teamwork, sportsmanship and discipline.

Be on time.

Learn the rules and play by them. Always be a good sport.

The coach's voice and directions should be followed above any other influences. It is the coach that decides playing time, and sending messages to players contrary to the coaches directions, could negatively affect the player, and team chemistry.

Respect your coach, your teammates, your parents, opponents and officials.

Never argue with an official's decision.

Do not engage in any form of abusive behavior toward any other person.
