What We Do

Support.

We have been supporting our neighbors with food, clothing, household items, and financial assistance.

Strengthen.

Our Workforce Readiness is a workshop program that provides training with resume/cover letter writing, interviewing skills, and general workplace social skills. We work with local job placement services, educational institutions and businesses to provide employment opportunities that lead to higher wages and upward mobility.

Client Services

Our client services' team is the first point of contact to our clients. They handle large volumes of clients by assessing their needs and eligibility. Clients will be able to sign up to our Workforce Readiness program to aid them in the path to self-sufficiency.

Office Dynamo. You will support staff with various office duties. You will answer phones and provide resource information to callers in need of assistance.

Food Pantry

Our food pantry serves our community who are experiencing hunger and food insecurity and provides them with essential emergency food assistance.

Pantry Fulfillment Specialist. You will be face to face with clients as you hand out food according to family size and dietary needs.

Pantry Resource Guardian. Quality control is your mantra. You will be behind the scenes processing the intake of food donated items. Donations are weighed, recorded, marked, rotated and stocked on shelves for distribution.

Thrift Shop

Our store is run entirely by volunteers who donate their time and talents to help us raise funds to supplement our food pantry. Volunteering at our thrift store is a great way to support our food pantry and serve our community!

Register Rockstar. As a cashier you are the first and last face seen by our customers so a pleasing personality, smile, and awesome counting skills are a must for this role.

Merchandise Maestro. This is where creativity and design skills are a plus. You will maintain the sales floor clutter free and visually appealing by managing the organization of stock and placement of a variety of household items.

Inventory Wizard. In this role you will inspect all donations by sorting, tagging, pricing, and placing donated merchandise to the sales floor.
