With all the new scams emerging, this is just a reminder that the IRS will almost always do its bidding via United States Mail. They will never call, email, text, or use social media to talk about a personal or business tax return and will not make threats of arrest or deportation or demand immediate payment using a specific payment type. They will always give tax payers an opportunity to challenge and appeal a decision.

If you receive any threatening calls, texts, or emails from someone you believe is impersonating the IRS in order to get your personal tax information report it to phishing@irs.gov

Unfortunately, scammers never rest so we have to always be vigilant and alert as they continue to come up with new tactics. Security is a huge priority! Never give personal or financial information out over the phone.
