First Lady's project is a sensory playground with musical instruments as music calms the soul!! Our directors of Texas Elks Childrens Camp need an area that is separated from the other playground where children that are a little overstimulated/agitated can be taken to calm down. This playground will be positioned between the playfield and the newly proposed pool (which has been funded!! YEAH!!) behind the building visible from the director's office. Below is an artist rendition of proposed playground. We can and will pick coordinating colors as all surfaces are customizable, but this gives everyone an idea of what we're thinking of. You can see the musical instruments in the foreground and ours will have more. It does have the glide rocker in this drawing, and we would add the "cocoon" for calming. Slides will be the ones we choose. The climbing geometric cubes help with calming as well as the kids can sit in them and feel safe, but care givers still have access to them and can still talk to them. I've also attached some specific pieces of playground equipment. If a District, individual, or business would like to sponsor one of the pieces of equipment we'll provide a tax receipt as well as a plaque will be placed on or near the piece of equipment noting the generous donation!!
