More than \$80,000 Awarded to Local Nonprofits

A t its annual awards presentation, held at Catawba Island Club on June 15, the Ottawa County Community Foundation (OCCF) awarded \$80,063 in grants and special recognitions. Thirty-eight local nonprofit organizations received funding, including OCCF's recipient of the third annual Joy Roth Little Tiger Award, The Arts Garage. The grants program supports a variety of county efforts in the fields of health, safety, human services, education, the environment and the arts. Funding for these grants was made possible by private donations and earnings from several unrestricted community funds and donor advised funds held by OCCF.

A product of OCCF's Special Initiatives Support Fund for Schools, one of the most significant 2023 awards was a \$20,000 grant provided for the Business Advisory Council's (BAC's) State Tested Nursing Assistant (STNA) certification program.

Joy Roth Little Tiger Award Presented to The Arts Garage

During the Awards Breakfast, the Foundation presented its 2023 Joy Roth Little Tiger Award to The Arts Garage (TAG), of the Greater Port Clinton Area Arts Council (GPCAAC). Joy Roth, founder and long-time President of OCCF, passed away in July 2020, and the OCCF Board, with the support of Joy's husband Jeff Roth, sought to establish this special recognition to honor her legacy. Joy, a fan of the Auburn University Tigers football team, was

known by family and friends to be a "little tiger" herself.

Created to recognize similar champions who go above and beyond to give back to the community, the award was presented to Jonnie Myers-Debbink and Carol Morgan, who spearheaded the aquistion and renovation of the historic (1935) Port Clinton city garage into an art space providing a studio for resident artists, writing groups, musical performances, dance, visual arts and more.

Its parent organization, GPCAAC, fosters a vibrant community through its public arts programming. The organization also offers scholarships to area youth, advocacy on behalf of artists/organizations and access to "arts and culture for all" in Ottawa County.
