High Country Pines Unit 1 HOA 2019 Annual Meeting Minutes

The 2019 High Country Pines Unit 1 HOA held their annual meeting on October 5, 2019 at the HOA office. The meeting was called to order at 10:04 am.

- 1. HOA President/Treasurer Steve Vasey welcomed the five homeowners in attendance at the meeting and introduced the Board Members: LaDean Burkhardt, member of the Architectural Committee; Dana Christensen, Green Belt Committee Chair; Don Plate, Architectural Committee chair. Secretary Kathy Somes was not in attendance.
- 2. A quorum of homeowners was not established, but all were in favor of continuing the meeting.

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2019 Greenbelt Committee Report

HCP HOA maintains 40 acres of forest land known as "the Greenbelt". The 2018 greenbelt contract to remove 116 dead trees was completed earlier this year at a cost of \$21,000.

In September 2019 an greenbelt assessment was made. Twenty-six dead trees were located and marked. The Greenbelt committee will complete another assessment in the spring of 2020. At that time, if the committee and the Board deem it necessary, action will be taken to obtain a minimum of three bids for another contract removal in 2020.

The Greenbelt Committee is working to schedule a representative from FIREWISE USA. This organization encourages residents to reduce wildfire risks. The committee thanks residents for maintaining their properties and taking a vested interest in our drought-ridden area. We all can do more.

The committee is pursuing Wildland Fire and Hazardous Fuels Grants through FIREWISE for the greenbelt area. The HOA pays up front with either 25 or 50 per cent of the cost being reimbursed. The process entails assessment by 3 contractors on the WFHF list and the HOA's approval.
