Mission: ALFA assists Trinity Services of Southwest IL to provide meaningful opportunities for adults with physical and intellectual disabilities to engage in activities that foster their physical, social and mental well-being using the resources and talents of family members, community supporters, and corporate sponsors.

ALFA is an all volunteer 501c3 organization which coordinates and funds music therapy, horticulture, art therapy, culinary, recreation, entertainment, sports, camping, boating, for adults with physical and intellectual disabilities on an on-going basis.
