

This year saw another increase of 200 over 2022, resulting in a growth of about 19% over the past two years. Obvious proof that our promotion utilizing post card reminders, the sign program and word of mouth are cost effective. Our sign placers did a great job! All vendors that I polled were pleased with the volume of their sales. They were also appreciative of all the help they received moving their wares in and out. This is something that other divisions rarely do and it goes a long way in attracting vendors to return. A huge thanks to all those volunteers as well as those who manned the admissions table, Membership Booth and worked with Frank Koch at the White Elephant table. Thanks to Bruce Knapp who did another stellar job with his re-wired test track and to Nancy Windes and Sam Swanson for sharing their talents with many attendees. A huge thanks and "well done" to the Fall Show leaders, Roy Hord, Randy Kerka, Pam Moleski, John Burchnall, Bob Shreve and Show Committee Chair Rick Crumrine.

I am writing this month's column while attending the Mid East Region's Convention in Altoona, PA. Other Division 7 members attending are Mike Tener, Bob Bartizek, Tim Stout, Jordan Kramer and John Burchnall, who is also presenting two clinics. Yesterday we took a bus trip to the East Broad Top RR. We rode a 100 year old electric trolley, and took an hour trip in their new narrow gauge coaches pulled by a restored Mikado. Later, we toured the round house where we found two other "Mikes" in different stages of restoration. Another highlight was a walk through a large and impressive machine shop with about twenty giant belt driven machines sitting in their original positions. There were two large steam boilers and engines to drive the overhead belt system that still works and is operated twice a year.

The next day, Mike Tener led me through several small towns while chasing a train up to Horse-shoe Curve. It rained most of the time and we climbed 150 steps to take videos of two trains on the curve at once. Wow! Worth getting wet for. Next adventure, a rail trip on the Cardinal to Springfield, MA for the Amherst Railway Society Train Show in January.

The Kenton County Library in Erlanger has asked us to host a model train outreach in conjunction with their Santa visit on Friday and Saturday, December 8 and 9. Larry Bonhaus and John Shields have designed an event with operating layouts and "Introduction to Model Railroading" presentations. Division 7 Officer Nominations 2024-2025 and Notice of Elections Occurring at November 12 Meeting

In accordance with the Regulations governing the conduct of elections in this Division of the Mid Central Region NMRA, our current Division 7 Nominating Committee presents the following candidates for elective office in Division 7 for the 2024-2025 term:

For Superintendent: Chuck Endreola

For Assistant Superintendent: Tony Valerius

This is now the final slate as no additional nominations were received from the floor at our October 8 membership meeting, nor via petition by the end of that meeting.

Our election procedures require our BOD to determine the voting method. Options include mailed or electronic ballots, or printed ballots or a show-of-hands at the November membership meeting. At our September 6 BOD meeting, the BOD decided 1) if the final slate was unopposed, to conduct the election via show-of-hands at our November 12 membership meeting, and 2) if either position had multiple candidates, to conduct the election via electronic ballots as we have done in the past. Since this final slate is unopposed, Teller Bob Shreve will conduct the show-of-hands election at our November 12 membership meeting.

We could not do the show-of-hands at our October meeting, as our regulations require us to give advance notice to the membership, which this notice fulfills. Also, a show-of-hands is quite sufficient for unopposed slates, as the State of Ohio (under which we are registered) does not allow write-in candidates in elections for organizations such as ours.

The newly elected officers will take office at the end of our January 14, 2024 membership meeting. In this case, both will then commerce their second consecutive 2-year term.



Division 7 Car Project (Limited Edition!)

Cincinnati Division 7's Car Project Committee is pleased to announce the availability of our latest, limited-edition car project!

Using Accurail's 2200 Series ACF 2-Bay Covered Hopper as the basis, we are offering it in a Norfolk & Western repaint scheme.

These cars are N&W class HC-46 and are from an original batch of fifty built in 1966 by ACF and were painted in the Round Herald paint scheme.

Sometime subsequent to that some cars went through a general maintenance program where they were repainted in the block N&W livery. Photos were found showing that at least three of these cars (road numbers 170753, 170768 and 170794) were reweighed at some later date because that area is "patched out" on the car with the new data displayed. Those same photos place these three cars as being in service in 1992 and 2004! It is these three, highly unique, road numbers that Cincinnati Division 7 is now offering for sale.

As with all Accurail cars, they are in kit form only.

Pricing is \$25 per car, or a 3-car set at \$70. Shipping (via USPS Priority) is \$9.20 for one car and \$16.25 for two to three cars.

Ohio residents, please add 7.8% sales tax on the total price of the kits and the shipping and handling fee.

I received these cars the week of 9/12. Heritage and purchasing details are posted on our Division 7 web site.


