Meeting called to order by the president at 6:04pm

Secretary

- October minutes posted online
 - Recommend approving October minutes
 - Seconded
 - o Pass unanimous

Treasurer

- Budget updates
 - Rocket Run funds so far at \$12,735
 - Final amount to be determined
 - Harvest Festival funds so far at \$6,176
 - Expenses approximately \$2,117
 - Approximately \$3,000 will go back to teachers
 - Elliott Ranch Merchandise
 - Made \$350 brandee check for merchandise sales, did completely
 - Carried out by office staff
 - Recommend \$350 be added to Staff Morale budget line, raising it from \$2,000 to \$2,350
 - Seconded
 - Pass unanimous
 - o TCSP still coming in, funds change to reflect reimbursements
 - Dine and Donate at Chuck E Cheese earned \$530
 - Will do Chuck E Cheese again throughout the year

 - Need colored shirts for students



Harvest Festival Chair

- Set up
 - Difficult, need more volunteers
 - 20 before and 20 after
 - Better with the event in the parking lot, safer
 - o 20 trunks last year, this year 27
- Stage
 - Bought for event, need to store
 - Principal might be able to get storage
 - Might still be in school
- Music by Volunteer
 - Next year need to figure out how to get music everywhere
 - Kids really enjoyed dancing on stage
- Paper divider between Trunk-or-Treat and the rest
 - o All paper donated by printer that can't use end of rolls
 - EXL helped with decorating banners
- Book Fair in Multi Purpose Room
 - More room
 - Used tables with Art Docent covers and student art
- Food
 - Next year use easy ups to make food obvious
 - o Issues with line, maybe use tape on ground
 - Food Chair noticed wasn't selling so took a cart of water and pie to people sitting around
- Issues:
 - Membership drive gave away Harvest Festival packages
 - Can't track how many people there
 - Next year make the membership level higher for that package
 - Next year maybe use tally counter to gauge attendance
 - Affects the money earned from Harvest Festival
 - Approximately \$3,000 in tickets and wristbands given away
 - Because of all the give away and tickets to teacher booth, only making \$1000
 - Next year take the money value of the package and reassign to Harvest Festival
 - Cakewalk got turned into bake sale
 - Musical chairs turned into nightmare
 - Just sold the prizes
 - Maybe next year have a screen for dancing activity
 - Maybe next year do PTO glow booth

 - o Two lines:

 - Need more parent volunteers
 - 20 people

- Rocket Run
 - So far PTO made approximately \$15,000
 - Last year made approximately \$14,000
 - o \$32,570 is the total raised so far
 - Half goes to APEX



- Still need to give a percentage to teachers
- Happy to have APEX back
 - High energy, A-Train seasoned fundraiser
 - Communication is a little more difficult with apex
- Small yard shade structure
 - Same options, similar prices as last year
 - Talked to Elk Grove District about how to advocate
 - Who to go to in the district, write grants, match funds, etc.
 - Maybe get support from community businesses
- New Songs/The Music Bus
 - Music program for Kinder through 2nd grade
 - 35 minute lesson in the classroom once a week
 - Grade 3 has recorders
 - Grade 4-6 already have optional band
 - Older grades may not have time for music
 - o \$6,000 for Kinder-2nd grade to do music every week until the end of year,
 - \$250 to add grade 4
 - President to look into cost for more grades
 - President to look into interest in music for higher grades
 - Motion to allocate \$10,000 for New Songs/The Music Bus for Kinder through Grade 2, with possible lessons for Grades 3-6
 - Seconded
 - Pass unanimous
