Treasurer

- Financial Report
 - Rocket Run funds went down because paid teachers
 - Spring Fling totaled \$8,000
 - More than estimated, but lower than previous year
 - Cost of 6th grade shirts \$71 over budget but less than \$100 over so a check was written for it
 - TSP spent a lot but still under budget
 - Yearbook:
 - Jostens only gave us 17 cents
 - Expecting \$1,000
 - Might still send a check
 - Previous year sent check in October
 - Membership is doing well
 - Spent a little bit on staff
 - Teacher breakfast
 - Folders for 2nd Grade
 - Ice Cream Social about \$100 under budget
 - Funds were raised from previous years

CSD Partnerships & Events Recreation Supervisor

- CSD willing to trade use of their facilities for services provided by your organization
 - Examples of services:
 - Your organization contracts to food prep at CSD events
 - Your organization provides raffle baskets for CSD events
 - Your organization leads a class provided through the CSD catalog
 - Your organization provides volunteers for CSD events at a \$29.99/hr rate
 - Currently about 45 organizations have EPPs with CSD
 - Other benefits of EPP with CSD
 - Under EPP might get \$100 insurance certificate waived
 - Might be able to use park lights for Harvest Festival
