- Roads Larry Murphy discussed a possible issue on 210th St East of Major Ave. The 3rd house put in a temporary approach, without a culvert to put an addition on their home. This approach was not approved by the board and is still there. There is concerns about the blockage of water flow in the ditch and possible backup onto the roadway. Brent will take a look and bring info to the next meeting.
- Road Concerns Larry Murphy stated the Brush on Omega still needs to be picked out of the ditch and there is a tree on O'day Ave (near Bruce Anderson's) that needs to be trimmed back. The board told Larry to go ahead and take care of both issues. This was taken care of No motion needed.
