

### **The Transfiguration: Elijah Shall Come & Restore All Things But First John The Baptist**

- As we go through this lesson, keep in mind what John the Baptist did at Christ first coming and what Elijah will do at his Second Coming; is the same thing Christ himself must do for the Father. Christ is the Messenger of the Father. Remember the Father sent and he speaks the words of the Father. Christ Sabbatical Kingdom is preparing the way for the TRUE LORD's Kingdom which is the Father's. SEE 1 CORINTHIANS 15:20-28
  - John the Baptist came in the spirit (countenance/mind; remember ruach/spirit can be Air, Mind, or spirit beings [Elohim, Angels, and later mankind after the first and second resurrection]) of Elijah to prepare the way during Christ's first coming as the lamb.
  - Elijah will prepare the way for Christ during his second coming when he comes as the lion of Judah.
1. Matthew 16:24-28
    - Taking up cross=denying your wants for what the Father wants. Examples: Willing to die/be martyred for the faith, keeping Sabbath even when it is not convenient, traveling to baptize someone, praying and reading your Bible even when you do not feel like, ministering to people when you do not want to, doing charitable deeds, giving to those who ask of you, treating others even your enemies with the love of Christ, etc....
    - Verse 28=Jesus tells his 12 disciples that some of them will not die before they see his Second Coming. Well the Second Coming has not happened yet and the disciples are all dead. So what did Jesus mean? He meant some of them would see his Second Coming in a vision. This was fulfilled by Peter, James, and John seeing visions of his Second Coming.
  2. Revelation 1:9-20
    - Lord's Day and Day of the Lord are the same thing. The Lord's Day is Sabbath and this is referring to his Second Coming and the establishment of his Sabbatical Kingdom/Millennial Reign. John was in the spirit on the Lord's day meaning he was shown a vision of the future. Specifically the Tribulation, Second Coming, Christ Kingdom, Judgement day, and the Father's Kingdom etc... Time is a fourth dimensional construct and the aliens (Elohim and Angels) can operate/travel in the fourth dimension. Sometimes the aliens allow humans to time travel to observe future events. The Day of the Lord is represented by the Day of Atonement. Christ's descent down to earth will be on Day of Atonement.

    - Transfigured=Strong's G3339 - metamorphoō The KJV translates Strong's G3339 in the following manner: transfigure (2x), transform (1x), change (1x).

μεταμορφῶω metamorphóō, met-am-or-fo'-o; from G3326 and G3445; to transform (literally or figuratively, "metamorphose"):—change, transfigure, transform.

- Essentially Metamorphosis. Like when a caterpillar changes to a butterfly. The body of Christ will go through this process at the First Resurrection. John, Peter, and James saw a vision of Jesus in his divine form/him at his Second Coming. Moses and Elijah were seen also in their future spiritual form after the First Resurrection. This was a vision of Christ Kingdom.
- Verse 9=Vision...Strong's G3705 - ὄραμα hórama, hor'-am-ah; from G3708; something gazed at, i.e. a spectacle (especially supernatural):—sight, vision. Examples of use: Act 7:31 "When Moses saw it, he wondered at the sight: G3705 and as he drew near to behold it, the voice of the Lord came unto him,(burning bush)" Acts 9:10-12, read some Acts 10 (verses 3, 17, & 19 have the word in them), Act 11:5 "I was in the city of Joppa praying: and in a trance I saw a vision, G3705 A certain vessel descend, as it had been a great sheet, let down from heaven by four corners; and it came even to me:" Act 12:1-9 (Notice Peter thought it was a vision not literally happening in that moment. So Peter, James, and John were not literally seeing Moses and Elijah in their literal time but a vision of the future. Verse 9 has the word.), Acts 16:9-10, & Acts 18:9-10. This is every instance the word is used in the Bible.
- Verse 10=Rightly so the scribes taught the Israelites that Elijah must come also when the Christ establishes his Kingdom on earth. The problem was most did not know that Christ was coming twice. The first time as the Lamb and second time as the Lion of Judah. Elijah will literally come after the First Resurrection at Christ Second Coming.
- Verse 11=Here Jesus is speaking in future tense. Elijah will help during the Sabbatical Kingdom/Millennial Reign to restore the Sacrificial/Levitical law and assist in helping the remnant of mankind understand the royal law. Restore means to re-establish. Ellicott's Commentary for English Readers: And restore all things.--Better, and shall restore. Leaving for the present the question who was to do the work, we turn to the nature of the work itself. Our Lord's language generalises the description given by Malachi. That work of "turning the hearts of the children to the fathers, and the hearts of the fathers to the children," was but part of a wider restoration of things and persons. Old truths were to be reproclaimed, and cleared from the after-growths of traditions. Men, as a race, were to be brought into their right relation to their God and Father.
- When we get to the two witnesses in Revelation we know Elijah is not one of them because those two witnesses did not restore anything nor did they turn the heart of the children and fathers. The world will hate those two witnesses and not listen to them.
- Verse 12=Jesus is speaking past tense. John the Baptist was already dead. Verse 11 and 12 by tense lets you know they are not talking about the same person. John the Baptist was a foreshadowing during Christ's first coming of what

Elijah will be doing during Christ's Second coming. John the Baptist came in the Spirit of Elijah just like Elisha.

9. 2 Kings 2:15

10. Luke 1:5-17

11. Mark 1:1-8

- John the Baptist prepared the people at Christ first coming. Resurrected Elijah will do the same thing at his Second Coming. Elijah will prepare the people at the beginning of the Millennial reign while the true third temple is being built.

12. 2 Kings 1:8

13. Malachi 4

- This is referring to his second coming

14. John 1:19-27

15. 1 Thessalonians 4:15-17 (Elijah will not be reincarnated. He will be resurrected on the last day like the rest of the dead in Christ: Those that died and ran the race of fearing God and Keeping his commandments till the end. After the First Resurrection Elijah will lead in restoring all things. Talk about saints and their jobs in the Kingdom. Priests, Judges, ruling cities, David will be prince of the world and King of Israel, Zerubabbel will build true third temple, 24 elders, 12 disciples will judge 12 tribes meaning they will be chiefs, etc... )

16. 1 Corinthians 15:50-54

17. Revelation 20:1-7

18. Matthew 17:11

19. Acts 3:17-21

- Verse 19=Refreshing=Resurrection on the last day. Repent and serve Yah now so he does not destroy you at his coming.
- Verse 20-21=After his death, burial, and resurrection Christ returned to the Third Heaven and will not return to earth until the restoration or re-establishment of the Sacrificial/Levitical law which will take place after his second coming. Right now we are in the new covenant and the sacrificial/levitical law was nailed to the cross. After his second coming he will re-establish the old covenant with the remnant of mankind left after the tribulation and armageddon.
- Resurrected Elijah in his spirit/glorified body will lead in the process of restoration. Restoration includes everyone coming to jerusalem to worship on feast days, new moons, and sabbaths. Yah will do a reset.

20. Isaiah 1:1-4\_24-28

- Verse 3=The Israelites do not know their God or who they are. In the Western Hemisphere they think they are moorish, kemet, native american/aboriginal, anything but what they really are which is Israel.
- Verse 26=This restoration will take place during the Kingdom and Elijah will lead in it.

21. Isaiah 66:15-24

22. Ezekiel 40:1-4

- Elohim allowed Ezekiel like John to time travelled in the fourth dimension to the Lord's day. He had a vision of the Sabbatical Kingdom/Millennial reign. Ezekiel 40 to the end of the book of Ezekiel is this vision.
23. Ezekiel 44
- The prince is David. See Ezekiel 37:15-28 & Ezekiel 34:22-25
24. Malachi 3:1-6
- Resurrected Elijah is this messenger for the Second Coming & John the Baptist for his first coming. John the Baptist was a Levite. See precept below.
  - Sacrificial/Levitical law/covenant will be re-established
25. Matthew 11:7-15
- Now if time permits we will deal with the two witnesses in revelation and show you Elijah is not one of them. If not skip to the last precept.
26. Zechariah 4:1-4\_11-14 (Two anointed ones. Two olive branches=Two cherubims on each side of Jesus. Out of the mouth of two or three witnesses let a matter be established. Same two angels that went to Sodom and Gomorrah.)
27. Exodus 25:31-40 (He asked about the two olive branches because the rest he understood from torah but not the two olive branches.)
28. Genesis 3:24 (Then said he, These are the two anointed ones, that stand by the Lord of the whole earth.)
29. Exodus 25:18-22
30. Psalms 99:1
31. Isaiah 37:16
32. Genesis 18:1-5\_16-22\_19:1-5
33. Deuteronomy 17:6 (Two or more witnesses needed to establish death sentence)
34. Deuteronomy 19:15
35. Revelation 11:3-15 (The two witnesses are two physical Israelites men that will prophesy during the length of the Great Tribulation so that the death sentence upon earth may be established.They could technically even be alive now or yet to be born.)
- Verse 3=They will do their work during the tribulation
  - Verse 4=They are doing the work of the two cherubims. I.E. to establish the matter. And the matter is lay down time
  - Verses 5-6=They F' up the earth even more in addition to the four horsemen and the seven angels with trumps/vials/bowls of wrath.
  - Verse 7=Testimony is them bearing witness. At the end of the tribulation they will be killed. This is how we know they are not the two cherubims literally nor are they Moses and Elijah or Enoch. The Bible does not teach reincarnation. Angels are spirit and spirit cannot die and it is appointed unto to man to die once so it cannot be Moses or Elijah. Enoch has already been transfigured. Prototype of those alive in Christ at his coming just like Christ was the first fruits of resurrection. See Hebrews 9:27 & Luke 20:34-38
  - Verse 8=That city is Jerusalem or right outside of Golgotha.
  - Verse 10=Their testimony being complete the matter is established evidence by mankind acting like it is Christmas at their death. We are

getting a test run of this with coronavirus. Mankind is trying to continue business as usual even though Elohim is F'ing them up.

- Verses 11-12=Either this is referring to them being caught up in First Resurrection or them being taken in whirlwind like and Elijah and dropped in the Wilderness where they will then being taken in the First Resurrection after the seventh angel see verse 15 which will be the same day.
