

The Unforgivable Sin: Forgiveness Requires Repentance

EXPLAIN WHAT THIS SIN IS OR THESIS STATEMENT (Refusing to admit wrong). USE EXAMPLE BUIE MISTAKE, DANIEL 8 MISTAKE, MY SUNDIAL MISTAKE.,

Review: Acts 7:51-53 “51 Ye stiffnecked and uncircumcised in heart and ears, ye do always resist the Holy Ghost: as your fathers did, so do ye. 52 Which of the prophets have not your fathers persecuted? and they have slain them which shewed before of the coming of the Just One; of whom ye have been now the betrayers and murderers: 53 Who have received the law by the disposition of angels, and have not kept it.” Isaiah 63:9-13 “9 In all their affliction he was afflicted, and the angel of his presence saved them: in his love and in his pity he redeemed them; and he bare them, and carried them all the days of old. 10 But they rebelled, and vexed his holy Spirit: therefore he was turned to be their enemy, and he fought against them. 11 Then he remembered the days of old, Moses, and his people, saying, Where is he that brought them up out of the sea with the shepherd of his flock? Where is he that put his Holy Spirit within him? 12 That led them by the right hand of Moses with his glorious arm, dividing the water before them, to make himself an everlasting name?” As demonstrated in scripture the Holy Spirit is God’s angel who gives man (Hebrew-Israelites) the “Law” or Word of God. The angel who led Moses and the Israelites through the wilderness. So the Holy Ghost or Holy Spirit is the Word of God or Law. SEE LUKE 1:19, LUKE 4:1-2, JOHN 7:38-39, ACTS 8:26-40, & Acts 10:1-8_19-22

- Blasphemy- The act or offense of speaking sacrilegiously about God or sacred things; profane talk.
- Sacrilege- Violation or misuse of what is regarded as sacred.
- Grieve- Cause great distress to (someone).
- Provoke- Stimulate or incite (someone) to do or feel something, especially by arousing anger in them. OXFORD ENGLISH DICTIONARY DEFINITIONS
- βλασφημία blasphemía, blas-fay-me'-ah; from G989; vilification (especially against God):—blasphemy, evil speaking, railing.
- What Are The Consequences for blaspheming and grieving the Holy Spirit?
- Matthew 12:31-32 “31 Wherefore I say unto you, All manner of sin and blasphemy shall be forgiven unto men: but the blasphemy against the Holy Ghost shall not be forgiven unto men. 32 And whosoever speaketh a word against the Son of man, it shall be forgiven him: but whosoever speaketh against the Holy Ghost, it shall not be forgiven him, neither in this world, neither in the world to come.”
- Mark 3:28-30 “28 Verily I say unto you, All sins shall be forgiven unto the sons of men, and blasphemies wherewith soever they shall blaspheme: 29 But he that shall blaspheme against the Holy Ghost hath never forgiveness, but is in danger of eternal damnation. 30 Because they said, He hath an unclean spirit.”
- Ephesians 4:30 “30 And grieve not the holy Spirit of God, whereby ye are sealed unto the day of redemption.”
- Exodus 23:20-22 “20 Behold, I send an Angel before thee, to keep thee in the way, and to bring thee into the place which I have prepared. 21 Beware of him, and obey his voice, provoke him not; for he will not pardon your transgressions: for my name is in him. 22 But if thou shalt indeed obey his voice, and do all that I speak; then I will be an enemy unto thine enemies, and an adversary unto thine adversaries.

- ANSWER: Eternal damnation in the lake of fire.
- The act of blaspheming the Holy Spirit is what grieves him and in turn provokes him to wrath. You blaspheme by speaking sacrilege against God and that which is sacred. That which is sacred is the Word of God, the Commandments, the Law, and the Bible; which are one in the same. Sacrilege is when you violate, misuse, or twist Holy Scripture (Bible) or claim someone else is doing so when they are not. Essentially in its rawest element; a person is blaspheming the Holy Spirit when they and or believe something is not a sin when the Bible clearly states it is. This means the person whether they realize it or not believes Christ died in vain because that was not really sin. SEE 1 JOHN 3:4 If you do not believe something is a sin/wrong which the Bible clearly tells you it is; then you cannot be truly repentant (poor in spirit) and make the Kingdom. That sin cannot be forgiven because you don't even believe it is a sin or wrong in the first place. 99.9 percent of homo-sapiens are in this situation. Repentance is required for forgiveness. Use Example: Jesus judge, holy ghost prosecutor, satan snitch, no forgiveness because you refuse the plea bargain because you say you did nothing wrong. They have video evidence if you refuse the plea bargain then they will be forced to give you what the law requires. You say no I am innocent and like the Last Mr Bigg take this ish to trial. You are going up under the jail.
- Examples:
 - The law has been done away with and gentiles are now God's people according to Paul. (Romans 3:31 and Romans 11:11-25)
 - Christ put an end to the law and the commandments when he died on the cross. (Matthew 5:17-19 and Matthew 27:19-20)
 - The concept of the Trinity. (Colossians 2:1-3_8-10)
 - Celebrating Pagan/Christian holidays that were established to replace the feasts of the Books of Moses by merging pagan festivals to create brand new church holidays. Like Christmas, New Years, Valentines day, halloween, Easter, Good Friday, Lent, etc... (Read Roots of Easter document, See Lent in Catholic encyclopedia online & Catechism of the Catholic Church book) Galatians 4:8-11
 - Claiming Sunday is the Lord's Day instead of Sabbath. (Exodus 20:8-11 and Luke 4:16)
 - Claiming you do not have to keep the law because of grace. (Hebrews 10:26-29)
 - Fornication: Use divorce and homosexuality as examples
- 1. Luke 3:1-18 (Fruits worthy/meet for repentance=Good works or keeping the law. If you are truly repentant/sorrowful you will admit you were wrong/sinned and stop doing that sin/wrong; thus keeping the LAW. This also ties into faith because faith is belief. Do you believe in Yah's word? Everytime John answers their questions he is telling them to stop doing a wrong that they think is not wrong and or justified.)

- 3. Numbers 23:19 (Elohim is never wrong therefore they do not repent. Times in the Bible where it says Elohim repented it simply means he decided to turn back/away/change from what he was about to do SEE JEREMIAH 4:28. Since he cannot be wrong it blasphemy when you say you are not wrong when Yah says you are.)

4. Acts 5:30-32 (Repentance is required for forgiveness of sins and eternal life. The unrepentant are blaspheming the Holy Ghost and cannot be pardoned of their sins. They refuse the plea bargain. The plea bargain is to admit you were wrong/confess to the crime/sin and never do it again. In return you get a CHANCE at eternal life or a lesser sentence like a few years and probation for the crimes you committed. Which will be immediate release with probation for time served because more than likely Elohim had already busted your head for your previous infractions. Probation equal keeping the law. Angels are P.O.'s reporting back to the Judge. You will get complete freedom meaning end of probation/eternal life by keeping the rules of your probation which represents Yah's word. If you refuse this plea bargain the minimum penalty is death or life in prison which represents the Lake of Fire. The prosecutor or Holy Ghost and judge or Jesus are bound by law to enforce the law if you refuse. And you are already guilty because they have video evidence literally.)

 - Verses 10-11=Elohim has already made Judgement. You cannot take the plea bargain at sentencing. Sentence has already been declared.
 - Verses 20-21=Saul refused to admit he was wrong thus rejecting the plea bargain.
 - Verses 24-25=It is too late on judgement day. The Holy ghost or word of Yah has convicted you. Sentence is given. He cannot pardon you.
 - Verse 26=Notice you have rejected the word of Yah...Essentially in its rawest element; a person is blaspheming the Holy Spirit when they and or believe something is not a sin when the Bible clearly states it is. This means the person whether they realize it or not believes Christ died in vain because that was not really sin.
10. Revelation 2:20-23 (As long as you are breathing you have space to repent. Explain though has some people end up dead/judged men walking. Mention Nabal and Exodus Pharaoh.)
