7:00 PM – Meeting Called to Order

7:02 PM – Situations

- Began with a couple of scenarios from Greg Leff
 - o The first had to do with high sticking; emphasis was that a high-stick was at the “opponents” shoulders, not necessarily your own
 - (USAH) See Note for Rule 621, page 190
 - (NFHS) HS of course uses the crossbar; Rule 7-10, page 38
 - o The second situation was the video/discussion for Head Contact
 - Emphasis on the “new” standard
 - (USAH) Rule 620, page 190
 - (NFHS) Rule 7-6, page 37
- Other discussions
 - o Golden Triangle; use of, positioning depending on where the puck is, etc.
 - o Scenarios of bench interference (with puck); where is face-off in each scenario
 - o “Turn-buckle” pads are IN play ...
 - o Scenario – if the puck is shot by the attacking team, it goes off the cross-bar, hits the glass, and lands on top of the net and play is stopped, where is the face-off? The conclusion was, it comes outside.
 - o Scenario – if a team dumps the puck in, it wraps around the boards and somehow ends up under the “curtain” around the bottom of the net, where is the face-off? It comes outside.
 - Note: be sure to check these, particularly at KRC before the game
