“Surely the Lord God does nothing, unless He reveals His secret to His servants” (Amos 3:7-8).

OUR FATHER IN HEAVEN

WE WERE MADE IN HIS IMAGE—TO RULE.

“Then God said, ‘Let **us** make mankind in **our image**, in our likeness, so that **they may rule** over the fish in the sea and the birds in the sky, over the livestock and all the wild animals, and over all the creatures that move along the ground’” (Genesis 1:26).

WE WERE **WONDERFULLY** MADE.

“I praise you because I am fearfully and wonderfully made; your works are wonderful; I know that full well” (Psalm 139:14).

WE ARE **HIS CHILDREN**.

“Now that faith has come, we are no longer under a guardian. **You are all sons of God** through faith in Christ Jesus. For all of you who were baptized into Christ have clothed yourselves with Christ” (Galatians 3:25-27).

“But to all who did receive Him, to those **who believed in His name**, He gave **the right to become children of God**” (John 1:2).

“The Spirit Himself testifies with our spirit that **we are God's children**” (Romans 8:16).

“**How great is the love the Father has lavished on us, that we should be called children of God!** And that is what we are!” (1 John 3:1)

WE FELL INTO SIN, SO HE IMPLEMENTED A **SAVING PLAN**.

“For God so loved the world that he **gave his one and only Son**, that **whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life**” (John 3:16).

“For just as through the disobedience of the one man the many were made sinners, so also **through the obedience of the one man the many will be made righteous**” (Romans 5:19).

HE **STILL** DESIRES FOR US TO BE IN HIS KINGDOM.

“So don't be afraid, little flock. For it gives **your Father great happiness to give you the Kingdom**” (Luke 12:32).

“No, the Father himself loves you **because you have loved me and have believed that I came from God**” (John 16:27).

“For you did not receive a spirit that makes you a slave again to fear, but you **received the Spirit of sonship**. And by him we cry, “**Abba, Father.**” The Spirit himself testifies with our spirit that

we are God's children" (Romans 8:15-16).

"Which of you, if his son asks for bread, will give him a stone? Or if he asks for a fish, will give him a snake? If you, then, though you are evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, **how much more will your Father in heaven give good gifts to those who ask him!**" (Matthew 7:9-11)

"Look at the birds of the air; they do not sow or reap or store away in barns, and yet your heavenly Father feeds them. **Are you not much more valuable than they?**" (Matthew 6:26)

"What do you think? If a man owns a hundred sheep, and one of them wanders away, will he not leave the ninety-nine on the hills and go to look for the one that wandered off? And if he finds it, I tell you the truth, he is happier about that one sheep than about the ninety-nine that did not wander off. In the same way **your Father in heaven is not willing that any of these little ones should be lost**" (Matthew 18:12-14).

"But **love your enemies**, do good to them, and lend to them without expecting to get anything back. Then your reward will be great, and you will be sons of the Most High, because he is kind to the ungrateful and wicked. **Be merciful, just as your Father is merciful**" (Luke 6:35-36).

"Do not let your hearts be troubled. **Trust in God; trust also in me.** In my Father's house are many rooms; if it were not so, I would have told you. I am going there to prepare a place for you" (John 14:1-2).

"When he came to his senses, he said... **'I will set out and go back to my father'**" (Luke 15:17).

Our Father in heaven loves us even though we have sinned. Mankind would have been a creation without hope, except for the noble, generous sacrifice of Christ who paid the price according to the law of God. A price—He only could afford because he is sinless. Both God, our Father and Jesus Christ love us so much that they will search out all who wander away—not willing that any should die. We were created to be God's children—sons of God! Our Father in heaven is merciful and yearns to gift us eternal life, so we can live with Him and His Son—in His royal family to rule in the greatest, most powerful, perfect loving kingdom ever to exist—MEMBERS of His royal family, not servants.

GOD'S BEGOTTEN—UNIQUE SON

YASHUAH/JESUS CAN BE TRUSTED.

"See, I lay a stone in Zion, a **tested stone** [Yashuah/Jesus], a precious cornerstone for a **sure**

foundation; **the one who trusts will never be dismayed**" (Isaiah 28:16).

YASHUAH/JESUS WAS A WILLING AND PERFECT SACRIFICE FOR US.

"I lay down my life ... No one takes it from me, but **I lay it down of my own accord**" (John 10:17-18).

"He humbled Himself and became obedient to the point of death, even the death of the cross" (Philippines 2:6-8).

"How much more, then, will the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit **offered himself unblemished to God, cleanse our consciences from acts that lead to death, so that we may serve the living God!**" (Hebrews 9:13-14)

YASHUAH/JESUS UNDERSTOOD THE LEVEL OF SUFFERING FOR OUR SALVATION AHEAD OF TIME.

"And He was withdrawn from them about a stone's throw, and knelt down, and prayed, saying, Father, if it is your will, take this cup away from Me; nevertheless, not My will, but yours, be done. **Then an angel appeared to Him from heaven, strengthening Him. And being in agony He prayed more earnestly. Then His sweat became like great drops of blood falling down to the ground**" (Luke 22:41-44).

YASHUAH/JESUS SUFFERED INHUMANE BRUTALITY UNTIL DEATH.

"See, my servant will act wisely; he will be raised and lifted up and highly exalted. Just as there were many who were **appalled at him—his appearance was so disfigured beyond that of any man and his form marred beyond human likeness—**so will he sprinkle many nations, and kings will shut their mouths because of him. For what they were not told, **THEY WILL SEE**, and what they have not heard, **THEY WILL UNDERSTAND**" (Isaiah 52:13-14).

YASHUAH/JESUS WAS DESPISED AND DISDAINED ON THE CROSS.

"But I am a worm and not a man, **scorned by men and despised by the people. All who see me mock me; they hurl insults, shaking their heads; He [Christ on the cross] trusts in the LORD [GOD our Father in heaven]; let the LORD rescue him. Let him [God our Father in heaven] deliver him [Christ/HaMashiach], since he [God our Father in heaven] delights in him [Christ/HaMashiach]...** You who fear the LORD, **praise him!** All you descendants of Jacob, **honor him! Revere him,** all you descendants of Israel! For he [God, our Father in heaven] has **NOT despised or disdained the suffering of the afflicted one[Christ]; he has not hidden his face from him but has listened to his cry for help**" (Psalm 22:6-24).

YASHUAH/JESUS' BLOOD WILL RECONCILE ALL THINGS ON EARTH AND IN HEAVEN.

"For God was pleased to have all **his fullness dwell in him [Christ], and through him [Christ] to reconcile to himself ALL things, whether things on earth or things in heaven, by making peace through his blood, shed on the cross**" (Colossians 1:19-20).

“Who Himself **bore our sins in His own body on the tree**, that we, having died to sins, might live for righteousness: by **whose stripes you were healed**” (1 Peter 2:24).

IF THEY KNEW THE PLAN, THEY WOULD HAVE PREVENTED THE CRUCIFIXION.

“None of the rulers of this age understood it, for if they had, **THEY WOULD NOT HAVE CRUCIFIED THE LORD OF GLORY**. However, as it is written: ‘No eye has seen, no ear has heard, no mind has conceived what God has prepared for those who love him’ but God has revealed it to us by his Spirit” (1 Corinthians 2:8-9).

THE ENEMIES OF GOD AND CHRIST DELIGHTED IN CHRIST’S SUFFERINGS AND DEATH ON THE CROSS.

“Many bulls of Bashan encircle me. Roaring lions tearing their prey open their mouths wide against me... Dogs have surrounded me; a band of evil men has encircled me... Deliver my life from the sword, my precious life from the power of the dogs. Rescue me from the mouth of the lions; save me from the horns of the wild oxen” (Psalm 22:12-21).

The ‘**bulls of Bashan**’ is an Old Testament version of the **gates of hell**, the **gateway to the underworld realm of the dead** where God has **imprisoned fallen angels and rogue sons of God**. Bashan was ruled by King Og, a giant—bloodline offspring of fallen angels. A species spawned to oppose God (Deuteronomy 3:1-11).

“He forgave us all our sins, having canceled the written code, with its regulations, that war against us and that stood opposed to us; he took it away, nailing it to the cross. And having **DISARMED THE POWERS AND AUTHORITIES**, he made a **PUBLIC SPECTACLE OF THEM, TRIUMPHING OVER THEM BY THE CROSS**” (Colossians 2:13-15).

“This is why it says: ‘When He ascended on high, **He led captives away**, and **gave gifts to men.**’ What does ‘**He ascended**’ mean, except that **He also descended to the lower parts of the earth? He who descended is the very one who ascended above all the heavens**, in order to fill all things” (Ephesians 4:8-9).

“The chariots of God are myriads, thousands upon thousands; The Lord is among them as at Sinai, in holiness. You have ascended on high, **You have led captive Your captives**; You have received gifts among men, **Even among the rebellious also, that the LORD God may dwell there. Blessed be the Lord, who daily bears our burden, The God who is our salvation.** Selah” (Psalm 68:17-19).

“For Christ also died for sins once for all, the just for the unjust, so that He might bring us to God, having been put to death in the flesh, but made alive in the spirit; in which **ALSO HE WENT AND MADE PROCLAMATION TO THE SPIRITS NOW IN PRISON, who once were disobedient**, when the patience of God kept waiting in the days of Noah, during the construction of the ark, in which a few, that is, eight persons, were brought safely through the water. Corresponding to

that, baptism now saves you—not the removal of dirt from the flesh, but an appeal to God for a good conscience—through the resurrection of Jesus Christ, who is at the right hand of God, having gone into heaven, **AFTER ANGELS AND AUTHORITIES AND POWERS HAD BEEN SUBJECTED TO HIM** (I Peter 3:18-22).

“Who has ascended into heaven and descended? Who has gathered the wind in His fists? Who has wrapped the waters in His garment? Who has established all the ends of the earth? What is His name or His son's name? Surely you know!” (Proverbs 30:4)

CHRIST’ CONQUEST resulted in an ascent and descent. The ascent, the resurrection back to life allowed Him to descend into the lower parts of the earth, where he declared his victory, then took the booty of his victory from the rebels. Then, he gifted it “some to be apostles, some to be prophets, some to be evangelists, and some to be pastors and teachers, **to prepare God’s people for works of services, so that the body of Christ may be built up until we ALL reach unity in the father** and in the knowledge of the Son of God and **become mature, attaining to the whole measure of the fullness of Christ”** (Ephesians 4:11-13).

YASHUAH/JESUS TRUSTED IN HIS RESURRECTION.

“Jesus said, ‘Do not hold on to me, for I have not yet ascended to the Father. Go instead to my brothers and tell them, ‘I am ascending to **my Father and your Father, to my God and your God”** (John 20:17).

Christ spoke with affirmation of Mary’s resurrection.

“But **God raised Him from the dead**, releasing Him from the agony of death, because it was impossible for Him to be held in its clutches” (Acts 2:24).

“And from Jesus Christ, the faithful witness, the **firstborn from the dead**, and the **ruler of the kings of the earth**. To Him who **loves us and has released us from our sins by His blood”** (Revelation 1:5).

“But there is an order to this resurrection: **Christ was raised as the first** of the harvest; then all who belong to Christ will be raised when he comes back” (I Corinthians 15:23).

YASHUAH/JESUS CAN UNDERSTAND OUR VULNERABILITIES; HE LIVED AS MAN AND GOD.

“The Word became **flesh and made his dwelling among us**. We have seen his glory, the glory of the one and only Son, who came from the Father, **full of grace and truth”** (John 1:14).

YASHUAH/JESUS ONLY IS OUR SAVIOR.

"Jesus said to him, **I am the way, the truth, and the life: No man comes to the Father except through Me”** (John 14:6).

"Nor is there salvation in any other, for there is no other name under heaven given among men by which we must be saved" (Acts 4:12).

CHRIST/HAMASHIACH willingly died, trusting that his Father would resurrect him and re-instate him with all His glory. Unlike the rogue sons of God who were defeated and imprisoned, are now waiting in judgment; they will die like mere men. Christ's resurrection back into glory is a confirmation that God our Father in heaven has accepted the price for our sins and upon our repentance, we too, will be resurrected. Christ/HaMashiach is the first of many more to come. ONLY through Christ can we come to know our Father. There is NO other way. Despite that some advocate technology or alternative religions, accepting Christ's sacrifice, repenting, and trusting him is the only way to salvation.

MANKIND—MALE AND FEMALE

IT IS GOD'S GOOD PLEASURE TO GIVE MANKIND THE KINGDOM

"Therefore, **the LORD longs to be gracious to you**, and therefore **He waits on high to have compassion on you**. For **the LORD is a God of justice**; How **blessed are all those who long for Him**" (Isaiah 30:18).

"**Set your minds on things above**, not on earthly things" (Colossians 3:2).

"**Now devote your heart and soul to seeking the LORD your God**. Begin to build the sanctuary of the LORD God, so that you may bring the ark of the covenant of the LORD and the sacred articles belonging to God into the temple that will be built for the Name of the LORD" (I Chronicles 22:19).

"How abundant are the good things that you have stored up for those who fear you, that you bestow in the sight of all, on those **who take refuge in you**" (Psalm 31:19).

"Yet **those who wait for the LORD will gain new strength**; they will mount up with wings like eagles, they will run and not get tired, they will walk and not become weary" (Isaiah 40:31).

"**How priceless is your unfailing love, O God!** People take refuge in the shadow of your wings" (Psalm 36:7).

"**Do not love the world or anything in the world**. If anyone loves the world, love for the Father is not in them" (I John 2:15).

"**Whoever wants to be a friend of the world makes himself an enemy of God**. Or do you think

that the Scripture says in vain, ‘The Spirit who dwells in us yearns jealously’? (James 4:4-5)

“Or do you disregard the riches of His kindness, tolerance, and patience, not realizing that **God's kindness leads you to repentance?**” (Romans 2:4).

LOVE CHRIST—YOUR BRIDEGROOM

“O righteous Father, although the world has not known You, yet I have known You; and these have known that You sent Me; and I have made Your name known to them, and will make it known, so that the **love with which You loved Me may be in them, and I in them**” (John 17:25).

“If you find my Beloved ... tell Him **I am lovesick!**” (Song 5:8)

“Let us not love in word or in tongue, but **in deed and in truth**. And by this we know that we are of the truth, and shall assure our hearts before Him” (1 John 3:18-19).

“If anyone loves Me, he will keep My word...” (John 14:21- 23).

THE ORDER OF AUTHORITY

“But I want you to realize that the **head of every man is Christ, and the head of the woman is man, and the head of Christ is God**” (1 Corinthians 11:3).

The order of authority:

1. God Almighty is head of all
- 2a. **Christ rules second in-charge** ruling over heaven and earth
- 2b. Christ's bride will co-rule with Christ as a unified body; he is the head and she is his body.
3. **Other heavenly rulers** continue to rule and hold their original positions in their domain, but now **they are under Christ's rule**
4. The remaining resurrected mankind will be subject to those above them.

“For this reason, a man will leave his father and mother and be united to his wife, and the two will become one flesh. **This mystery is profound, but I am speaking about Christ and the church**” (Ephesians 5:23).

“And **he is the head of the body, the church**; he is the beginning and the firstborn from among the dead, so that in everything he might have the supremacy” (Colossians 1:18).

THE BRIDE WILL BE MADE READY

“Search me, O God, and **know my heart; try me**, and know my anxieties; and see if there is any wicked way in me, and **lead me in the way everlasting**” (Psalms 139:23-24).

“Who can understand his errors? **Cleanse me from secret [unperceived] faults**. Keep back Your servant also from presumptuous sins ... **Then I shall be blameless**” (Psalms 19:12-13).

“He who begun a good work in you will complete it until the day of Christ ... I pray that your love may abound ... that you may **be sincere and without offense till the day**” (Philippians 1:6-10).

RUN TO WIN

“Those who run in a race all run, but **one receives the prize? Run in such a way that you may obtain it** ... Therefore, I run thus: not with uncertainty [lack of focus] ... I discipline my body and bring it into subjection, lest ... I should become disqualified” (1 Corinthians 9:24-27).

SHE WILL BE RADIANT

“He did this to present her to himself as a **radiant church without a spot or wrinkle or any other blemish**. Instead, she will **be holy and without fault**” (Ephesians 5:27).

“Then I saw a **new heaven and a new earth**, for the first heaven and earth had passed away, and the sea was no more. I saw the holy city, **THE NEW JERUSALEM, COMING DOWN OUT OF HEAVEN FROM GOD, PREPARED AS A BRIDE ADORNED FOR HER HUSBAND**. And I heard a loud voice from the throne saying: “Behold, **the dwelling place of God is with man, and He will live with them. THEY WILL BE HIS PEOPLE, AND GOD HIMSELF WILL BE WITH THEM AS THEIR GOD**” (Revelation 21:2). **HE WHO OVERCOMES WILL INHERIT ALL THIS**. (Revelation 21:6).

Every detail of our Father in heaven’s plan is written in the scriptures for ALL to read. Now, every eye has seen, every ear has heard, and the heart of every person can image the glory that awaits us—if you will only believe!
