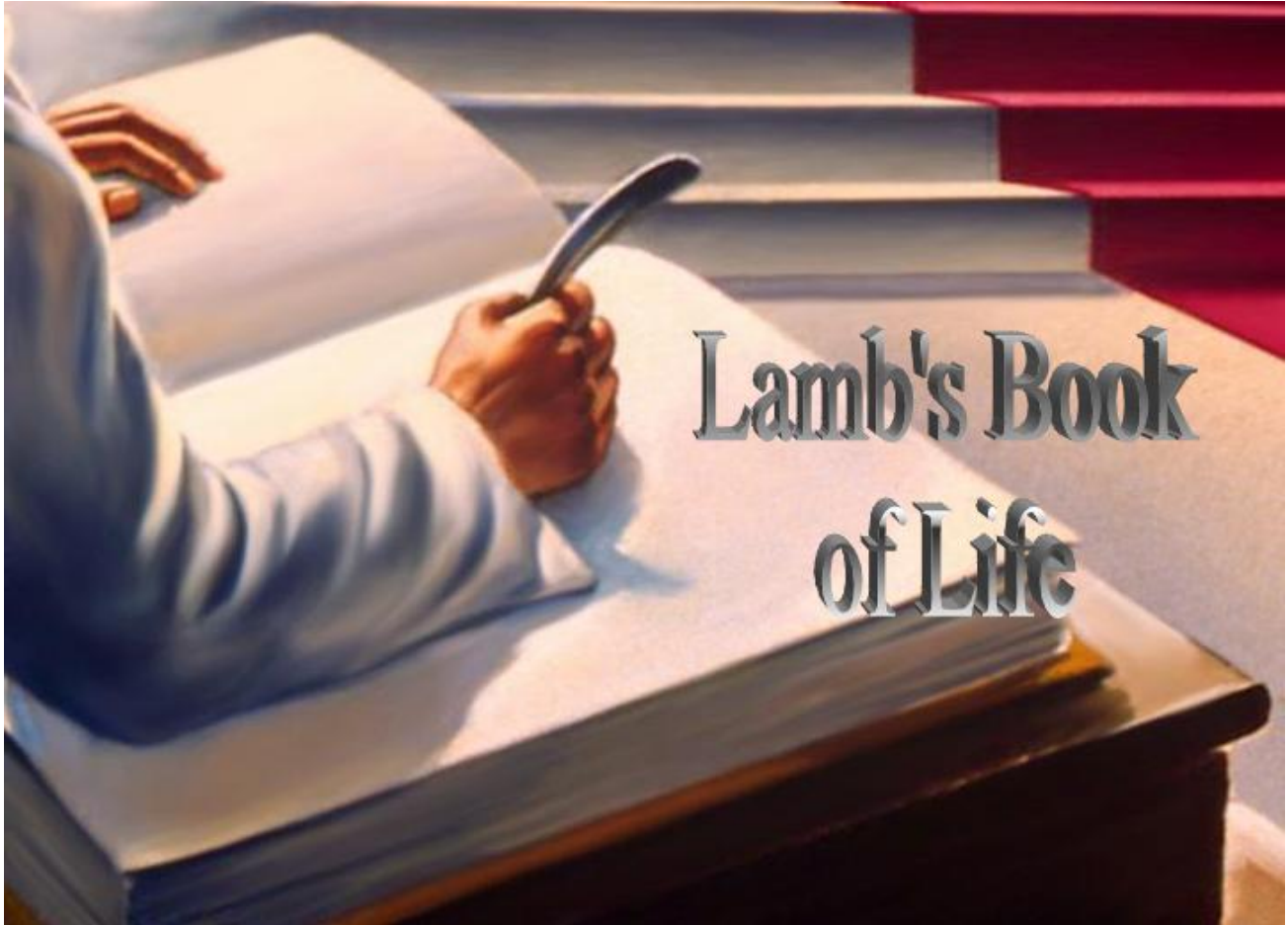


The Books

The Book of LIFE

“Another book was opened, which was the **book of life**. The dead were judged according to what they had done as recorded in the books” (Revelation 20:12).

“Indeed, true companion, I ask you also to help these women who have shared my struggle in the cause of the gospel, together with Clement also and the rest of my fellow workers, **whose names are in the book of life**” (Philippians 4:3).

“He who overcomes will thus be clothed in white garments; and **I will not erase his name from the book of life**, and I will confess his name before My Father and before His angels” (Revelation 3:5).

“And nothing unclean, and no one who practices abomination and lying, shall ever come into it, but **only those whose names are written in the Lamb's book of life**” (Revelation 21:27).

“Add iniquity to their iniquity, and may they not come into Your righteousness. **May they be blotted out of the book of life and may they not be recorded with the righteous**” (Psalms 69:27-28).

“All who dwell on the earth will worship the beast, **everyone whose names have not been written in the book of life belonging to the Lamb that was slain from the creation of the world**” (Revelation 13:8).

“The beast that you saw was, and is not, and is about to come up out of the abyss and go to destruction and those who dwell on the earth, **whose name has not been written in the book of life from the foundation of the world**, will wonder when they see the beast, that he was and is not and will come” (Revelation 17:8).

“Anyone whose name was not found written in the **book of life** was thrown into the lake of fire” (Revelation 20:15).

“Then Moses returned to the LORD, and said, ‘Alas, this people has committed a great sin, and they have made a god of gold for themselves. But now, if You will, forgive their sin—and if not, please **blot me out from Your book** which **You have written!**’ The LORD said to Moses, ‘Whoever has sinned against Me, **I will blot him out of My book**’” (Exodus 32:31-33).

“You have taken account of my wanderings; Put my tears in Your bottle. Are they not in **Your book?**” (Psalm 56:8)

“Your eyes have seen my unformed substance; And in **Your book** were all written. The days that were ordained for me, when as yet there was not one of them” (Psalm 139:16).

Your names are WRITTEN IN HEAVEN

“The seventy returned with joy, saying, “Lord, even the demons are subject to us in your name!” And Jesus said to them, “I saw Satan fall like lightning from heaven. Behold, I have given you authority to tread upon serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy; and

nothing shall hurt you. Nevertheless, do not rejoice in this, that the spirits are subject to you; but **rejoice that your names are written in heaven.**" (Luke 10:17-20)

For all who repent and accept Christ as their Savior, their name will NOT be blotted out of the Book of Life. They will receive eternal life.

The Book of REMEMBRANCE, The Book

"Then those who feared the LORD talked with each other, and the LORD listened and heard. **A scroll of remembrance was written in his presence concerning those who feared the LORD and honored his name. 'THEY WILL BE MINE,' says the Lord Almighty, 'in the day when I make up my treasured possession. I will spare them,** just as in compassion a man spares his son who serves him. And you will again see the distinction between the righteous and the wicked, between those who serve God and those who do not" (Malachi 3:16).

"Now at that time Michael, the great prince who stands guard over the sons of your people, will arise and there will be a **time of distress** such as never occurred since there was a nation until that time; and at that time your people, everyone who is found written in **the book, will be rescued**" (Daniel 12:1)
