BIOGRAPHY

- Karen Hudson was born to Don and Shirley Hudson of Spirit River, Alberta. After completing high school Karen attended the University of Alberta beginning in 1985. For two years, Karen worked at Campus Recreation and at the Lister Hall Student Residence. In 1988 she ran for election as U of A Student Body President. In 1989 Karen was appointed to the VP-Academic Advisory Committee for the University of Alberta.
- Following the March 20, 1989, Provincial Election, Karen began work as a Summer Student for the Alberta Government Caucus in the Legislature Office of the Honourable Robert (Bob) Bogle. In August Karen was then hired to serve as Executive Secretary to the seven-member All-Party Legislative Committee called the Select Special Committee on Electoral Boundaries with the Honourables Robert Bogle (Chair), Stockwell Day and Mike Cardinal of the Government Caucus, Pam Barrett and Tom Sigurdson of the New Democrat Caucus, and Percy Wickman and Frank Bruseker of the Liberal Caucus.
- Nearing the conclusion of the mandate for the Select Special Committee, Karen was hired as a Researcher for the PC Government Caucus Research Branch and served those elected in the 1989 and 1993 Alberta General Elections, most specifically, the Honourable Pearl Calahasen, Glen Clegg, Robert (Butch) Fisher and John Drobot.
- Karen Hudson and Peter Kuhnert married in 1989. After Peter completed his Family Medicine (MD, FCFP) and Anesthesia (GPA) training, the couple moved to Inuvik, NWT and became Co-owners of Arctic Family Medical House, historically Canada's most northern privately owned Medical Clinic. In their seven years in Inuvik, Karen additionally led the effort to bring the circumpolar Arctic Winter Games to the Canadian arctic Delta. And she was part of innovation teams working to develop community infrastructure in Inuvik (pool, arena, museum and church-community center).
- In 2000, the Kuhnert family of five launched in Waterloo, Ontario to attend Waterloo Lutheran Seminary.

 The Reverend Doctor Peter Kuhnert (MD, MDiv.) was ordained in 2006 and Called to serve Maranatha Caribbean Lutheran Congregation. The Reverend Karen Kuhnert (MDiv.) was ordained and Called to St. James Lutheran Church in Baden in 2008.
