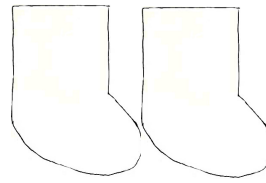
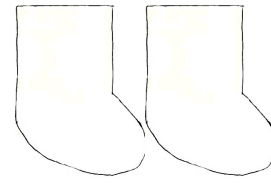


CHRISTMAS STOCKING

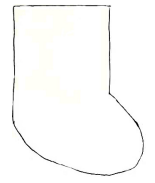
1. Using pattern for stocking, cut (2) pieces from lining fabric, (2) pieces from out-side fabric and (1) piece from thin batting or fleece.



OUTSIDE

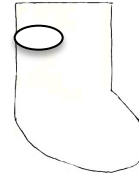


LINING

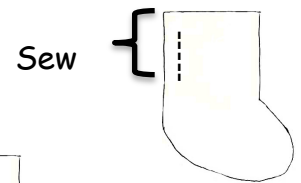


BATTING

2. Sew batting/fleece to the wrong side of one of the outside fabric pieces. Attach a hanging loop of ribbon or a fabric loop to the side of the stocking. Remember to have the loop on the right side of the fabric.

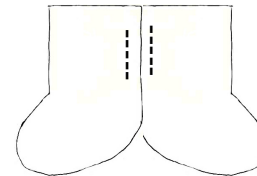


3. Sew (2) Lining pieces together at the back from the top edge down about 3 inches.

4. Sew (2) outside pieces together at the back from the top edge down about 3 inches.

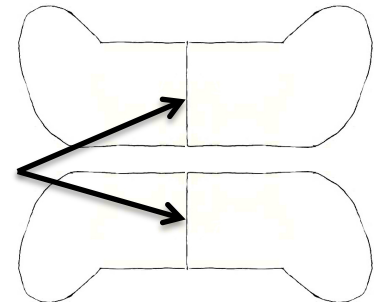


Sewn about 3"

5. Open each piece out flat.

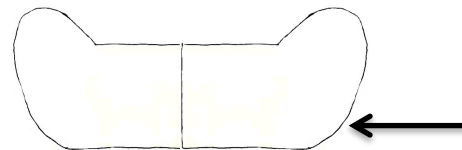
6. With right sides together, sew tops of lining and outside pieces together across the top only.

Sew together



7. Fold this unit in half lengthwise.

8. Starting at the back about 4 inches below the seam sewn in the lining, sew all the way around both stockings, leaving this opening for turning.

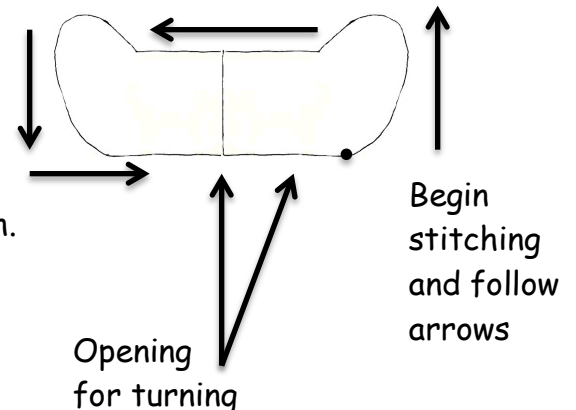


Looks like this

9. Turn stocking inside out.

10. Fold in opening and close either by machine or handstitch.

11. Tuck lining into stocking.
